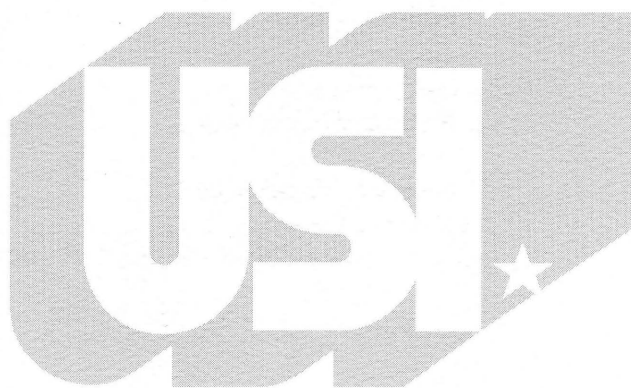

WILL BRING COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS AND BE HONORED FOR LEADERSHIP IN EDUCATION AND BUSINESS

The Commencement Address will be delivered by Dr. George B. Weathersby, who has enjoyed a distinguished career in the fields of education and business. He came to Indiana as the State's Commissioner for Higher Education, and during his six years in that post, Dr. Weathersby guided a series of studies of Indiana's higher education programs and began the work to improve access to public programs for all Hoosiers. As a result of his review, it was recommended that the University of Southern Indiana be established as a separate state university. That recommendation became reality two years after he left the Commission, and he was appointed to serve on the first USI Board of Trustees in 1985. Dr. Weathersby was a member and officer of the Board until 1991, when he moved from Indiana. He will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in recognition of his achievements in shaping higher education opportunities in Indiana.

Dr. Weathersby earned the Bachelor and Master of Science degrees in engineering and a Master of Business Administration degree in managerial economics from the University of California at Berkeley. He also holds a Doctor of Philosophy degree in decision and control from Harvard University. In the 1970s, Dr. Weathersby held faculty and administrative positions at the University of California and at Harvard University. He also was a White House Fellow, and in that capacity held positions as special assistant to the Secretary of State and director of research and associate staff director for the National Commission on the Financing of Postsecondary Education.

His background in higher education prepared him well for his appointment in 1977 as Indiana Commissioner of Higher Education, a post he held until 1983 when he became president and chief operating officer of The Curtis Publishing Company in Indianapolis. In 1986, he joined Ontario Corporation, a diversified manufacturing company on whose board of directors he had served for several years. Dr. Weathersby was corporate vice president for finance and later president of the Muncie-based company which has operations in California, Indiana, Florida, and Oklahoma. In 1991, he became a partner in Founders Court, Incorporated, a private investment management company in Princeton, New Jersey.

A member of several professional organizations, Dr. Weathersby also serves on the board of directors of several corporations, including United Student Aid Funds, the USA Group, Holnam, and Farm Fans. He is a member of the Board of Trustees of Butler University. Dr. Weathersby and his wife Linda have two children.

WILLIAM A. KOCH **WILL BE HONORED FOR REGIONAL LEADERSHIP**



In recognition of his efforts to enhance economic development in southern Indiana, William Albert Koch, developer of Holiday World, will receive the honorary Doctor of Laws degree in the Commencement ceremony. Many regional projects have had the benefit of Mr. Koch's entrepreneurship. In 1956, he conceived a relocation plan for Interstate 64. The plan was adopted and moved the Indiana section from a

Louisville-Loogootee-Vincennes route to its present alignment. He was instrumental in the sixties in establishing the Lincoln Boyhood National Memorial in Lincoln City, and later in that decade, led incorporation efforts for the town of Santa Claus, serving as the first town board president. Mr. Koch also established the community's first bank, the Spencer County Bank, in 1969. His successful enterprises near Santa Claus have made the town the fastest-growing community in the State.

A lifetime southern Indiana resident, Mr. Koch was raised in Evansville, where he graduated from F. J. Reitz High School in 1932. He received his baccalaureate degree in mechanical engineering from Purdue, and took post-graduate work in naval architecture at the U.S. Naval Academy. Mr. Koch served in the Navy Reserve and was on active duty during World War II.

After the war, he resumed work in his grandfather's Evansville company, George Koch Sons, where he had worked during high school and following college. He became executive vice president and director of the company.

Since 1946, Mr. Koch has been active in the development of Holiday World Theme Park, formerly called Santa Claus Land, where he has been president and director. Currently he is the chief executive officer of Santa Claus Land, Inc., the parent company of Holiday World; Christmas Lake Golf Course and Club; Fairway Pines Condominiums; and Lake Rudolf Outdoor Resort.

Mr. Koch has served as chairman of a number of state tourism associations. He also chaired the first membership drive for Historic Southern Indiana, a tourism development project of the University of Southern Indiana. He has been an active member in the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions, and involved in several state, political, civic, community, historical, and religious organizations.

Mr. Koch and his wife Patricia are the parents of five children and two grandchildren.

BETTYE B. McCUTCHAN **WILL BE RECOGNIZED FOR DEDICATION TO UNIVERSITY**



Bettye Burchfield McCutchan has been a life member of the University of Southern Indiana Foundation Board of Directors since 1974 and has served continuously as secretary of the Board since 1980. She has given her leadership to the Foundation's nominating and executive committees and has been actively involved in each of the University's fund-raising endeavors. She will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in recognition of her extraordinary service to the University.

Mrs. McCutchan is an Evansville native who graduated from Bosse High School and was educated at Indiana University, where she was a member of Delta Gamma sorority. In addition to her work for the University, she has been a leader in civic and cultural activities in Evansville.

Mrs. McCutchan has been an active volunteer for the Evansville Museum of Arts and Science. A member of the Museum Guild, she has served as its chair of Ways and Means. She also has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra Guild and the Evansville Arts and Education Council. For ten years, Mrs. McCutchan served on the Board of Directors of the Evansville Blind Association and for eight years, she was a member of the Board of the Evansville Day School.

St. Mary's Medical Center and its Foundation also have been the beneficiaries of Mrs. McCutchan's talents. She currently is the chair of the Foundation's Art Acquisition Committee, which helps to arrange donations to the Medical Center's collection and proper display of the art works. Through her membership on the Board of Directors of St. Mary's Foundation, she has played key roles in fund drives and in special events for the benefit of the Center's projects.

Mrs. McCutchan is the widow of John E. McCutchan, who was an insurance executive and a trustee of Indiana State University in the developing years of the Evansville campus. Mrs. McCutchan has one daughter and two grandchildren.

DR. ALDO F. CARDARELLI IS 1992 DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR



In the words of a colleague who nominated Dr. Aldo F. Cardarelli for the 1992 Distinguished Professor Award, "he has been, and is, a pre-eminent model for us all. He truly has the qualities of wisdom, sympathy, justice, integrity, courage, and the ability to inspire others."

Dr. Cardarelli, professor of education and chair of the Teacher Education Department, came to the University of Southern

Indiana in 1974. From that time forward, he has been engaged in professional activities which demonstrate his commitment to excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service – the criteria which faculty colleagues measure in choosing the recipient of this annual award. He will receive a monetary award and a scholarship in his name will be awarded to a deserving USI student. The award is made possible by a generous gift from National City Bank of Evansville.

Dr. Cardarelli was educated at LeMoyne College, where he earned his bachelor's degree, and at Syracuse University, where he was awarded both the Master of Arts and Doctor of Philosophy degrees. He taught in the public schools of Syracuse, New York, and on the faculty of Syracuse University, Utica College, and University of Nevada-Las Vegas before coming to USI.

A specialist in teaching reading, Dr. Cardarelli won a \$265,000 Lilly Endowment grant in 1990 for his innovative proposal to expand the reading interests of middle school teachers and ultimately to improve the quality and quantity of reading among middle school students. More than 50 Indiana school districts have participated in the "Teachers Under Cover" project. Dr. Cardarelli continues as the administrator of this grant in addition to successfully managing new duties this year as chair of the Department of Teacher Education.

USI students regard Dr. Cardarelli as a rigorous and inspirational teacher whose love of his profession and of reading is contagious. They also know him as a dedicated advisor of Kappa Delta Pi, national honor society in education, which he has served continuously for 15 years. In 1990, Kappa Delta Pi presented him the Honor Key for "outstanding contributions to the field of education."

Many University and community projects are the beneficiaries of Dr. Cardarelli's interest and involvement. He has been chairman of the USI United Fund Campaign, a member of the Faculty Senate, and several Faculty Senate and University ad hoc committees. Dr. Cardarelli also chaired the state textbook selection committee of southwestern Indiana. He has been a cub master in the Boy Scout organization, a volunteer for Channel 9, and the Salvation Army, and involved in children's projects such as Head Start, Project SELF, and the public library's Story Hour. Widely published, Dr. Cardarelli has had articles accepted in the most prominent education journals. *The Reading Teacher*, a journal of the International Reading Association, plans to publish his article on the "Teachers Under Cover" grant project this spring.

DEBBIE L. SEIB IS 1992 PRESIDENT'S MEDAL RECIPIENT

In the Commencement ceremony, Debbie L. Seib will receive the 1992 President's Medal, the highest honor given a senior at the University of Southern Indiana. Mrs. Seib is being graduated *magna cum laude* with majors in accounting and computer information systems.

The Faculty Senate Student Academic Affairs Committee chose Mrs. Seib for the President's Medal because of her commitment to academic excellence and her service to the University and the community.

A consistent dean's list student, Mrs. Seib has led the USI Inter-Business Council and Administrative Management Society as president, has been treasurer of the Data Processing Management Association, and has been a member of the Accounting Club, History Club, Student Ambassadors, and Student Alumni Association. As a senator in the Student Government Association, she has represented the School of Business and was named Outstanding Senator of the Year in 1989-90. Her chairmanship of USI's Adopt-a-Spot program resulted in attractive campus-wide landscaping displays sponsored by student groups.

Mrs. Seib has reached beyond the campus and accepted responsibility for several community projects. She was chairperson of communications for Evansville's Thunder on the Ohio hydroplane races, and also chaired several committees for the Outboard Boating Club of Evansville. She has volunteered for the Channel 9 Auction and the March of Dimes Walk-a-Thon. Among Mrs. Seib's honors are selection for Golden Key National Honor Society, the USI Honors Symposium, *Outstanding Young Women of America*, and *Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges*.

Mrs. Seib and her husband Michael reside in Evansville. She is the daughter of James William Walker and the late Jennie L. Walker.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in the holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads.

Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

The Mace of the University

In medieval England, the mace was a formidable weapon, held ready by a bodyguard who led the way for dignitaries or officers of the court. From the sixteenth century in England and since colonial days in America, the mace has become a symbol of office only, and is carried by a distinguished member of the faculty who leads the Commencement procession. Here, it is carried by the Grand Marshal.

The University's official Mace is the cane of Richard Owen, who was a geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University before becoming the first president of Purdue University. A respected scientist and scholar, Richard was a son of Robert Owen, the Scottish industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. All the children of Robert Owen who accompanied him to America made far-reaching contributions to society, and helped to shape the governmental, social, and cultural directions of the state, region, and nation.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremonies are receiving lapel pins as a gift of the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association. The pins bear the University logo.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index will be graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher will be graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 will be graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.
