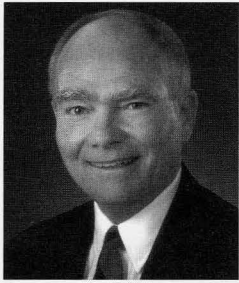

UNIVERSITY WILL HONOR THREE



Joseph E. Kernan

Today's Commencement Exercises will honor three individuals for their accomplishments in their careers and their contributions to education and society. The Commencement Address will be given by Indiana's **Lieutenant Governor Joseph E. Kernan.**

Lieutenant Governor Kernan grew up in South Bend, Indiana, the oldest of nine children. He was a catcher on the baseball team at the University of Notre Dame and graduated in 1968 with a major in government.

Lieutenant Governor Kernan entered the United States Navy in 1969 and served as a naval flight officer aboard the U.S.S. Kitty Hawk. In May of 1972, he was shot down by the enemy while on a reconnaissance mission over North Vietnam and was held as a prisoner of war for nearly 11 months. Lieutenant Governor Kernan was repatriated in 1973 and continued on active duty with the Navy until December 1974. For his service, he received numerous awards, including the Navy Commendation Medal, two Purple Hearts, and the Distinguished Flying Cross.

After completing his Naval service, Lieutenant Governor Kernan worked for Procter and Gamble in Cincinnati in 1975. He then returned to South Bend, where he worked for both the Schwarz Paper Co. and the MacWilliams Corp. He was city controller of South Bend from 1980-84.

Lieutenant Governor Kernan was elected mayor of South Bend in 1987 and subsequently re-elected for two additional terms, winning 82 percent of the vote in 1995. He is the longest-serving mayor in the city's history.

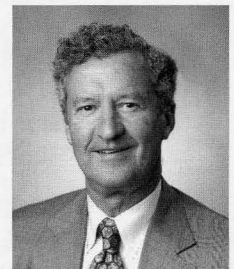
In 1996, Frank O'Bannon and Kernan were elected to the top two positions in Indiana government. The O'Bannon-Kernan team was elected for a second term in 2000. As lieutenant governor of Indiana, Kernan serves as the president of the Indiana Senate, the director of the Indiana Department of Commerce, and as the commissioner of Agriculture.

Among Lieutenant Governor Kernan's many accomplishments during his tenure in office are the creation of the Agricultural Crisis working group, dedicated to ensuring the prolonged productivity of the agriculture industry; the Veterans Outreach Initiative, which has resulted in thousands of Hoosier veterans learning about the state and federal benefits they have earned; the insurance Industry Working Group, an organization led by Lieutenant Governor Kernan that successfully achieved legislative initiatives that improve the business climate for the state's insurance industry; the continued growth of the state's workforce, to a point where more Hoosiers than ever before are working; and the restructuring of the state's tax system, which was based largely on a plan laid out by the lieutenant governor, protecting homeowners from potentially huge property tax increases and making the state a more attractive place to do business. Also under his direction, the state has stepped up its international presence, finding markets for \$14 billion worth of Hoosier goods shipped abroad and adding six new countries where Indiana operates a foreign trade office or partnership.

Lieutenant Governor Kernan and his wife Maggie have a home in South Bend where she is a marketing specialist for First Source Bank.

In recognition of the Lieutenant Governor's prominence in public service, the University will confer an honorary Doctor of Laws degree on him in today's ceremony.

Robert E. Griffin is chairman of the board of Escalade Inc. and a prominent business leader. He has given leadership to numerous initiatives of the University of Southern Indiana through the USI Foundation, which he served as board chair, and the School of Business Board of Visitors. Mr. Griffin also is a member of the Community Advisory Council for the Evansville Center of the Indiana University School of Medicine, which is located on the USI campus.

FOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

After receiving his Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from University of Notre Dame, Mr. Griffin served in the U.S. Navy Civil Engineer Corps. Following service, he earned the Master of Business Administration degree from Northwestern University. In 1960 he came to Evansville as production supervisor of Futura Inc., and in 1962 he was one of a group of investors who purchased Indian Archery Corp., a small but well-established Evansville manufacturer of archery products. Indian Archery became part of Escalade Sports through an acquisition in 1973. During the past 75 years Escalade Sports has evolved into a highly regarded global company within the sporting goods industry known for quality products and brands, new product development, unparalleled customer service, and quick-turn shipping capacities.

An innovative manager, Mr. Griffin played an integral part in establishing a nationally recognized wellness program that provides insurance rate discounts for employees who maintain healthy lifestyles.

Mr. Griffin also has given guidance to several businesses, including St. Mary's Medical Center Building Corp., Wendy's Restaurants in Utah, DECEM Inc., Sweden Table Tennis AB, Abbey Press, and Gateway Medical Resource Alliance. He is a director of American Mutual Insurance Co. and formerly was chairman of Acordia of Evansville and a director of United Physicians Health Network Inc.

Mr. Griffin and his wife Judy have been generous supporters of University students and programs. They have supported the prestigious Presidential Scholarship program since its inception in 1988, both personally and through Escalade Inc. They also have endowed the Dr. John and Grace Helfrich Eisterhold Scholarship in honor of Mrs. Griffin's parents. Mr. Griffin led the fund drive that established the Robert D. and Mary Kay Orr Business Scholarship at USI.

In recognition of his contributions to the University and his leadership in the business community, Mr. Griffin will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in today's ceremony.

Olive Carruthers Clift is a native of New Castle, Indiana, and a graduate of Indiana University, receiving a bachelor's degree in 1929 and a master's degree in 1939. Throughout her undergraduate college years she worked as a Western Union telegraph operator. Because no teaching positions were available immediately after her graduation, she worked full time for Western Union through December 1931 and then every summer until 1959.

In January 1932 she began teaching social studies and government at Ben Davis High School in Indianapolis. She taught for 41½ years, and when she retired in 1973, she had achieved the longest single teaching career since Ben Davis was founded.

Mrs. Clift married an Evansville native, Homer L. Clift, in 1973 and moved to Evansville that same year. They lived close to the University and took an active interest in its development. Mr. Clift died in 1982.

Mrs. Clift was a longtime member of Speedway (Indiana) Christian Church and for 25 years, she was a member of Opti-Mrs, until the Evansville chapter closed in 1999. An active member of the Evansville Retired Teachers Association, she served as president in 1979–80. She also was a member of the Indiana Retired Teachers Association and a charter member of Indiana chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa, the International Honorary Society for Women Educators.

Mrs. Clift established endowed scholarships at Indiana University and at the University of Southern Indiana. She said she did so out of love for education and to help other students as she had been helped by her receipt of a full scholarship—then \$37.50 for each semester she attended college.

In recognition of her distinguished career in teaching and her commitment to help others receive a college education, she will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Southern Indiana.

WALTER JERMAKOWICZ AND JOHN MCNAUGHTON TO RECEIVE UNIVERSITY'S HIGHEST HONORS

The University's highest honors will be awarded during today's ceremony to Walter J. Jermakowicz III, a senior from Evansville, and John W. McNaughton, professor of art.

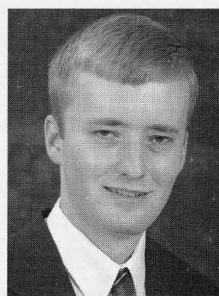
The Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty Senate selected Mr. Jermakowicz as this year's recipient of the President's Medal. He was chosen because of his commitment to academic excellence and his service to the University and the community. Mr. Jermakowicz will graduate *magna cum laude* with three degrees—a Bachelor of Science with a major in biology, Bachelor of Science with a major in chemistry, and Bachelor of Arts with a major in German.

Mr. Jermakowicz has served for two years as the student representative to the USI Board of Trustees, appointed by the governor of Indiana.

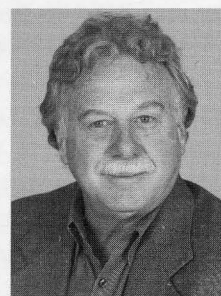
His many honors include receiving the national Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship, a Fulbright Scholarship, the USI Trustees Distinguished Merit Award, and the USI Spirit of the Eagle Award. He also has won many prestigious study and research opportunities including summer research fellowships at the Mayo Clinic and Washington University. Mr. Jermakowicz is widely published in professional and scientific journals and has presented his research at meetings of international societies.

An active student leader, Mr. Jermakowicz has been Student Government Association vice president for Student Affairs and Activities, attorney general, and treasurer. He was selected by SGA for the Top 10 University Leaders Award and for the Member of the Year Award. Mr. Jermakowicz also has served on the USI-New Harmony Foundation Board of Directors and the USI Athletic Board.

Fluent in English, German, and Polish, Mr. Jermakowicz has studied in Germany and Poland, where he co-founded the Polish Chemical Society Student Division. He has been active in the Association of German Students, the USI Student Affiliates Chapter of the American Chemical Society, and the Health Occupation Students of America, which he served as Indiana state

vice president. In addition, Mr. Jermakowicz has been an active participant in USI Intramural Sports.

In the Evansville community, he has been a youth group leader at St. Mary's Catholic Church and served as a judge for the Tri-State Regional Science Fair, high school speech and debate contests, and the Cynthia Heights Elementary School Science Fair.

Mr. Jermakowicz is the son of Dr. Eva Jermakowicz, USI associate professor of accounting, and the late Walter J. Jermakowicz Jr. He plans to enter a joint MD/PhD program to study neurodegenerative diseases. His goal is to be a professor in a medical school, where he can see patients, do full-time research, interact with students, and have a positive global impact in scientific research and medical therapeutics.

Other finalists for the President's Medal were Kendra Maasberg, Nathaniel Rivers, and Karen Schnellenger.

Professor McNaughton was chosen by his colleagues to receive the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor Award, given in recognition of significant achievement in teaching, scholarship, and service. An internationally regarded sculptor who is known for his "highly imaginative and technically masterful wood sculptures," Professor McNaughton also has taught and worked extensively in metals. He has been on the USI faculty for 33 years.

Professor McNaughton recently was one of 100 international artists chosen to participate in Emma Lake International Conference. He also was asked to exhibit in an international exhibition in Toronto this year. Professor McNaughton has received two

National Endowment for the Arts awards, and his most recent, an NEA Fellowship for \$20,000, was the highest award of its type granted. It subsequently led to his selection as one of only 10 visiting lecturers from across the nation for a United States/Mexico cultural exchange program. His work has been featured on the cover of *American Craft* magazine, a prestigious and coveted honor.

He has raised community awareness of the arts by creating public art in Evansville. Outdoor utilitarian and often monumental sculptures created by Professor McNaughton and his students adorn the USI campus, The Centre, and the Evansville Museum of Arts, History, and Science. In collaboration with architects for new USI buildings, he has directed the work of students who created contemporary sculptures for the USI Liberal Arts Center and the Orr Center.

Professor McNaughton's sculptures have been exhibited extensively throughout the United States at the Smithsonian Institute's Renwick Gallery, the Ohio Craft Museum, the Atlantic Center for the Arts, Leo Kaplan Modern in New York, the Sculpture and Functional Objects International Exposition in Chicago, and in numerous one-person and group gallery exhibitions. His work is part of the Smithsonian Institute's permanent collection and the White House Craft Collection, and is featured in more than 300 museum, corporate, and private collections. Professor McNaughton has been invited as a Visiting Artist to more than 20 universities and important art centers such as Penland School of Crafts, the Appalachian Center for Crafts, and Art Park.

Professor McNaughton has a long record of service to the University, the School of Liberal Arts, and the Art Department. He has served as chair of the Art Department as well as on numerous committees and is given credit for shaping the curriculum not only of the Art Department, but also of the University in its early years. A colleague who nominated him for this award wrote, "He has attained significant achievement in all categories of teaching, scholarship, professional activity, university service, and community service."

Former students have developed lifelong relationships with Professor McNaughton and speak of his passion, energy, encouragement of creativity, and high standards. They also laud his friendly mentorship and extraordinary love of teaching.

The recipient of many awards, Professor McNaughton has been recognized by the USI Alumni Association with its Faculty Recognition Award, by the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana with its Educator of the Year Award, and by *Indiana Arts Insight* magazine, which named him an "Indiana Treasure."

Professor McNaughton received the Bachelor of Science in art education and a Master of Arts in sculpture from Ball State University. He also earned the Master of Fine Arts in sculpture from Bowling Green State University in 1970, the same year he joined the faculty of USI.

As Distinguished Professor, Professor McNaughton will receive a grant from Integra Bank, will select a student to receive a scholarship in his name next year, and will deliver the Distinguished Professor Lecture during the next academic year.

Presidential Medallion

During the Middle Ages, medallions signified membership in religious orders and guilds and, in the Renaissance, membership in elite orders of knighthood and prominence in government office. Today, colleges and universities strike medallions to commemorate important events and achievements. The University of Southern Indiana Presidential Medallion signifies the authority invested in the president.

Fabricated in bronze, the Presidential Medallion celebrates the 1995 inauguration of President H. Ray Hoops. At its center the bronze medallion bears a three-inch reproduction of the University seal, surrounded by a half-inch rim; on the back of the medallion are the names and dates of appointment of the University's presidents. During today's ceremony, a replica of the Presidential Medallion will be presented to Walter J. Jermakowicz III. This is the highest honor given to a graduating senior.

University Seal

The University seal bears the University's colors—red, white, and blue—with gold. The shield signifies the importance of higher education in defending citizens against ignorance. Between the two banners carrying the University's name appear a band and an open book bound together by the torch of knowledge. In the band, rays of light emanate simultaneously from a rising sun, symbolizing the young University, and from the torch, symbolizing the light of knowledge and the passion for scholarship. Trees on either side of the flame suggest not only the University's pastoral southern Indiana setting but also life, growth, and continuity.

Beneath this band, an open book emphasizes the importance of teaching and learning; *academia populi* and *academia populo* indicate that the University of Southern Indiana is a scholarly academy

founded and supported by *the people, for the people*. Finally, the laurel branches to the right and left of the book represent victory: the light of learning overcomes the darkness of ignorance.

University Mace

In the Middle Ages, bodyguards of French and English monarchs carried ceremonial maces. Later, the mace became an important symbol of office in civil processions and academic pageantry; at the University of Southern Indiana, the Grand Marshal, a distinguished member of the faculty, carries the mace.

A replica of the walking cane of Richard Owen (1810-1890) serves as the centerpiece of the University mace. A respected geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University, Owen became the first president of Purdue University. He was a son of Robert Owen (1771-1858), the Welsh industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. The 32-inch-tall wooden cane was presented to Richard Owen in 1874 and, through the generosity of his descendant Kenneth D. Owen, served as the Grand Marshal's staff until the mace was fabricated for the University's first Presidential Inauguration in 1995.

Designed and fabricated by Nicholas Logsdon of Indianapolis, the University mace encloses a replica of the Owen cane and is gold-plated. At the top, above the cane's golden head, an open orb holds a replica of the University seal. The free-flowing design of the orb symbolizes the interrelationships among all academic disciplines. Below the cane's tip are three golden rings engraved with the names and appointment dates of the University presidents. A finial at the tip of the cane bears the names of Kenneth Dale Owen, Jane Blaffer Owen, and James A. Sanders, donors of the mace.

Designed and created by alumnus Kenny Fisher '77, the replica of the cane and the base are made of walnut from the Owen mansion built in New Harmony during the 1830s.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremony are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift from the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.

University Honors Scholars

The designation of University Honors Scholar is awarded to students who successfully complete the Honors Program. They can be recognized in today's ceremony by the white honors cords worn with their regalia.

Photography During Ceremony

A commercial photographer is taking photographs of each graduate as she/he shakes hands with the president. Each graduate will receive a proof from which duplicates can be ordered. Family members who wish to take still or video photographs during the ceremony are asked to use the restricted area on the floor. Security guards will ask those who block aisles in the stands or occupy the area behind the stage to move. Your cooperation ensures the dignity of the Commencement ceremony.

Commemorative Video

In response to requests from graduates and families, a high quality commemorative videotape of today's ceremony is being produced by the USI Office of Instructional Technology Services in cooperation with the USI Alumni Association. The tape includes the entire ceremony, depicting each graduate receiving a diploma, as well as candid behind-the-scenes shots.
