Newspaper Editor Judith Clabes Will Bring Commencement Address

An individual who helped forge community support for making USI a separate state university, Judith G. Clabes, will be the speaker at today's 20th Commencement. Mrs. Clabes has been editor of *The Kentucky Post* since 1983. A native of Henderson, Kentucky, she received a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Kentucky and the Master of Public Administration degree from Indiana State University.

A former high school journalism teacher and reporter for the *Evansville Courier* and *Henderson Gleaner*, Mrs. Clabes has used the newspaper as a partner in education. Mrs. Clabes was the director of the Newspaper in Education program at the Evansville Printing Corporation and she has written a guide for using newspapers to teach disadvantaged children. She was editor of *The Sunday Courier & Press* in Evansville for five years, and edited *New Guardians of the Press*, a book profiling selected women editors which was published in 1983.

Mrs. Clabes serves on the Board of Directors of the American Society of Newspapers Editors (ASNE), is vice-chair of the Kentucky Educational Television Authority, and is a member of the Northern Kentucky Action Committee for Excellence in Education, the Northern Kentucky University Foundation, Leadership Kentucky, and Northern Kentucky Chamber of Commerce.

Her list of achievements is exemplary. Highlights include serving on the Legislative Research Committee for Long Range Planning, founding the University of Kentucky First Amendment Center, and serving as a member of the Kentucky Constitution Revision Commission. She also served on the Pulitzer Nominating Jury, was president of Kentucky Associated Press Editors Association, and chair of the Board of Visitors for the University of Kentucky School of Journalism. In 1984 Mrs. Clabes was a member of the ASNE delegation to the Soviet Union. Last fall she received the prestigious University of Kentucky Distinguished Alumni Award.

She will receive the honorary Doctor of Letters degree for her work in journalism, education, and the important role of advocate for the establishment of a separate state university in Evansville.

Mrs. Clabes and her husband Gene have two teenage sons, and live in Walton, Kentucky.



Daniel Miller Lauded As Educator, Architect of Social Science Programs

Dr. Daniel A. Miller graduated from Hanover College with honors in 1940. He earned the Master of Arts and the Doctor of Philosophy degrees from the University of Michigan. A World War II veteran, he was a teaching fellow at Michigan, then served as an educational consultant at Camp Breckinridge, Kentucky, during the Korean conflict mobilization. In 1962 Dr. Miller returned to teaching at Oakland City College before joining the USI faculty.

A member of the USI Centennial campus faculty, Dr. Miller made the classroom a part of his professional life as a complement to his administrative role as chairman of the Division of Social Science. A popular teacher, he was voted the USI Alumni Association's Outstanding Teacher in 1983. As division chairman, Dr. Miller continued his commitment to bringing quality education to students of USI. He spearheaded the growth of the division from the early days when he and Professor Walter Wahnsiedler were the only faculty members to a program of academic excellence offering disciplines in seven departments which have had more than 1,000 baccalaureate graduates. He retired in 1988.

He has written several publications, including the first work to be published by a member of the USI faculty, *Sir Joseph Yorke and Anglo-Dutch Relations, 1774-1780* published in 1971. He also has compiled a personal narrative of the history of the University, *How the South Won: The Making of USI*, to be published this year.

Realizing responsibility for community service, Dr. Miller served on the Project for Law Focused Education, an effort to coordinate the teaching of law in local schools. He also was active as a Board member of Evansville's Halfway House, and of the Southwestern Indiana Regional Council for Aging (SWIRCA).

For recognizing the opportunities of USI in its early development and nurturing the academic disciplines, the faculty, and the students of the social sciences, Dr. Miller will receive the honorary Doctor of Laws degree. Dr. Miller and his wife, the former Jean Hart, have six children and 11 grandchildren. The Millers reside in Princeton, Indiana.



USI Graduate John Fehrenbacher, Transplant Surgeon, Honored

John W. Fehrenbacher, M.D., a cardiovascular and thoracic surgeon, has done pioneer work in organ transplant at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana for seven years. He performed the first lung transplant and the first heart-lung transplant in the State of Indiana last year.

An Evansville native, Dr. Fehrenbacher is a graduate of Mater Dei High School. He was a member of the first graduating class at USI, receiving a baccalaureate degree in science in 1971. He graduated from the Indiana University School of Medicine in 1976. Dr. Fehrenbacher has done extensive work in animal research on options for a failing heart. He currently is developing avenues to assist a weakened heart by using a patient's own abdominal muscle to do pulsing for the heart muscle. In experimental stages, Dr. Fehrenbacher is also working on an electro-mechanical heart as a life saving endeavor for the future.

As a lecturer, Dr. Fehrenbacher educates health professionals about organ transplants and talks with lay groups throughout the country on heart disease and preventive care for the heart.

Dr. Fehrenbacher will receive the honorary degree Doctor of Science for his developmental work in organ transplant surgery and his research expertise.

Dr. Fehrenbacher is married to the former Cindy Funke, a 1972 USI graduate. They have three sons and live in Indianapolis.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in the holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design its wearer's degree and its institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

The Mace of the University

In medieval England, the mace was a formidable weapon, held ready by a bodyguard who led the way for dignitaries or officers of the court. From the sixteenth century in England and since colonial days in America, the mace has become a symbol of office only, and is carried by a distinguished member of the faculty who leads the Commencement procession. Here, it is carried by the Grand Marshal.

The University's official Mace is the cane of Richard Owen, who was a geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University before becoming the first president of Purdue University. A respected scientist and scholar, Richard was a son of Robert Owen, the Scottish industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. All the children of Robert Owen who accompanied him to America made far-reaching contributions to society, and helped to shape the governmental, social, and cultural directions of the state, region, and nation.

Scholarship Honors

The student graduating with the highest scholarship index will be graduated summa cum laude. Students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher will be graduated magna cum laude. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 will be graduated cum laude. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by the colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates summa cum laude; red, magna cum laude; and blue, cum laude.
