Pitching Clinics (Advanced): Pitchers that are more advanced and would like to work on control, velocity, learning and/or working on new pitches. Must bring your own catcher.

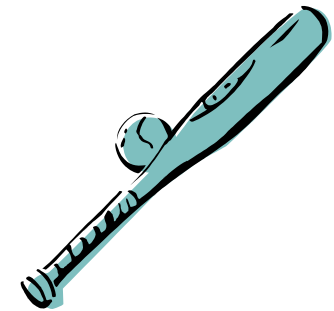
Catching Clinics: A clinic for catchers to work on receiving pitches, framing, blocking, throwing and all other fundamentals that make a great catcher.

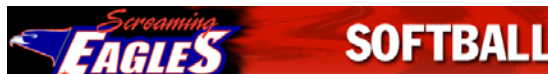
