

## **Job Description of Faculty Research Leaders**

### Faculty Research Leader Obligations

- Faculty will direct students in undergraduate research each workday during the eight-week Summer Research Program.
- Each Friday during the eight-week Summer Research Program, faculty will assist students in providing research updates at the weekly seminar.
- Faculty will mentor and guide undergraduate research students and assist in preparing a comprehensive research presentation.
- Faculty must commit to participate in the program for two consecutive summers, and the academic year between the summers.
- Faculty will not teach during the eight-week Summer Research Program. Faculty will not take vacation during the eight-week Summer Research Program.
- Faculty are ineligible for stipends or fellowships during the eight-week Summer Research Program.
- Faculty will meet each week with research students during the academic year.
- Faculty will be paid a \$4000 stipend for their participation in the Summer Research Program.
- Faculty will have \$300 allotted for each student to use for research supplies.
- Faculty will have \$300 allotted for each student to use for travel to present their research at a professional meeting.

### Faculty Research Leader Application

- Faculty will submit a formal application.
- Faculty will provide an outline of research area(s), objectives, methods, goals, etc.
- Faculty will provide a current resume.
