

Deutscher Akademischer Austausch Dienst (DAAD)

Purpose	Support international academic cooperation, offering programs and funding to students, faculty, researchers and others in higher education.
Award <i>Number & Amount</i>	Undergraduate Scholarship: Monthly stipend approximately 650 Euros plus additional funds to defray travel and research expenses and health insurance. Graduate Scholarship: Study Scholarship- Monthly stipend approximately 750 Euros, health insurance and flat rate subsidy for travel costs.
<i>Duration</i>	Undergraduate Scholarship: minimum 4 months (one semester); maximum 10 months (one academic year). Must take place during German academic year. Graduate Scholarship: Study scholarship- 10 months (one academic year) with possibility of one-year extension;
Eligibility <i>Who</i>	US and Canadian citizens or permanent residents. Foreign nationals eligible if have completed one year at US or Canadian institution and will return to finish Bachelors degree after program. Graduate scholarship: graduating seniors must be enrolled in accredited university at time of application. Foreign nationals completed two years at US or Canadian institution.
<i>When</i>	Undergraduate Scholarship: Junior or Senior year. Graduate Scholarship: during enrollment of program.
<i>Selection Criteria</i>	Possess outstanding academic records and personal integrity. Have well-defined study, research, or internship plans for stay in Germany. Demonstrate an interest in German and European affairs. Are younger than 32 at start of grant period.
Deadline	Undergraduate Scholarship: Late January. Graduate Scholarship: November
Application	Application form online. Submit original printout with signature, supplemental documents, and materials. 3 copies in one package for Undergraduate, 5 copies for Graduate Scholarship and Research grant. Supplemental information listed on website.
