

LEAN ENTERPRISES GREEN BELT SHOWCASE

Join us for a morning showcasing the University of Southern Indiana's Lean Enterprise Green Belt training and certificate program.

The five-day classroom training is designed to provide a practitioner's level of understanding and application of the Lean Six Sigma Process Improvement methodology. Student will learn to apply the model to any process, including hospital, transactional, and manufacturing. Basic Lean principles and tools such as Value Stream Mapping & Analysis, 5S workplace organization, and Poke-Yoke will be presented. Principles and tools from the Six-Sigma discipline will include data collection and sampling, intro to data-based decision making, statistical analysis, and the DMAIC process.

Upon completion of the one week of training, the student will be prepared to assist their organization in implementing Lean Six Sigma improvement activities. Completion of the USI Green Belt Certification requires completion of the five-day course, successfully passing the Green Belt test, and completion of a project within the student's organization. Investment in this program will pay for itself as each project should return four to 10 times the cost of the class.
