



OSHA 503 Update for General Industry Outreach Trainers



This course is a valuable refresher for active trainers in the general industry outreach program. Trainers are required to take this course every four years to stay current with OSHA standards and safety initiatives, as well as Outreach Program changes. Participants have the opportunity to:

- Learn about the latest OSHA general industry standards, policies, and regulations.
- Analyze interpretation letters that affect general industry.
- Improve training techniques.
- Conduct and receive valuable feedback on their own training.
- Renew their outreach trainer card.

Participants who successfully complete the course are authorized to conduct and issue OSHA course completion cards for 10- and 30-hour general industry safety and health outreach courses.
