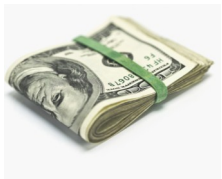

Scholarship Details

Each year, the Epi-Hab Scholarship Program awards six one-time \$1,000 scholarships to USI students. To encourage participation from all students, there will be a winner from each college/division with at least three qualified applicants. The balance of the scholarships will be awarded on an at-large basis.

Scholarship funds will be deposited in winners' USI accounts. Funds will be distributed in the fall and spring semesters (50% per semester) following the award, and may be used toward educational expenses incurred at USI including tuition, course fees, textbooks, and housing.

Each winner has a maximum of four calendar years in which to use the award (from the first registration period following the award) **i.e., winners from the 2012-2013 year will be able to utilize the award beginning with the fall semester of 2012, but not before.** Therefore, **students expecting to graduate in Spring 2012 should not apply.**

Please Note: The scholarship award will not cover expenses incurred prior to winning the scholarship.

Eligibility

Who Should Apply:

Students who have a disability, or assist individuals with disabilities in either their personal lives or workplace, are encouraged to apply.

Who is Eligible:

To be eligible for the Epi-Hab Scholarship, applicants will:

1. Be currently enrolled in classes at USI at the time of application and scholarship award. (If you will be graduating Spring 2012, you will be ineligible.)
2. Have completed at least (12) semester hours OR have transferred (12) semester hours to USI.
3. Have a minimum GPA (grade point average) of 2.7 for undergraduate and 3.0 for graduates.

Requirements

To be considered for the scholarship, each student should submit a completed Epi-Hab Scholarship application packet.

Each Packet Contains:

- One Epi-Hab application
- One printed essay
- Two letters of recommendation

The essay should contain the following:

- Name (on every page)
- Address
- Contact phone number
- College name and major

Each essay should describe your proposed field of study and future career plans. Include how these plans will support USI's mission to help advance the knowledge and understanding of disability in America and within our community (see application for complete details).
