Scholarship Details

The Epi-Hab Scholarship Program awards a onetime \$1000.00 scholarship to one student from each of the five colleges within the University of Southern Indiana and one from *University Division/Extended services:

- The College of Business
- The Bower Suhrheinrich College of Education and Human Services
- The College of Liberal Arts
- The College of Nursing and Health Professions
- Pott College of Science and Engineering
- *University Division/Bachelor of General Studies, Extended Services

Scholarship funds will be available for educational expenses incurred at USI such as tuition, course fees, textbooks and housing.

Eligibility

Who Should Apply

Students who have a disability or assist individuals with disabilities in either their personal lives or workplace, are encouraged to apply.

Who is Eligible

To be eligible for the Epi-Hab Scholarship, applicants will:

1. Be currently enrolled in classes at USI (at the time of application and scholarship award).
2. Have completed at least (12) semester hours **OR** have transferred (12) semester hours to USI.
3. Have a GPA (grade point average) of 2.7 for undergraduates and 3.0 for graduates.

Requirements

Requirements

To be considered for the scholarship, each student will submit a complete Epi-Hab Scholarship application packet.

Each Packet Contains:

- One Epi-Hab Application
- One Printed Essay
- Two Letters of Recommendation

The Essay should contain all of the following:

- Name (on every page)
- Address
- Contact Number
- College Name and Major

Each essay will describe your proposed field of study and future career plans; include how these plans will support USI's mission to help advance the knowledge and understanding of disability in America and within our community (see application for complete details).
