Vernon, Indiana. Visitors enter the campus via an overpass from University Parkway off Highway 62. The campus is accessible from Interstate 64 and US 41. From Interstate 64 take the US 41 south exit to Evansville. At the Lloyd Expressway exit, go west off US 41. Continue west on the Lloyd Expressway (approximately 8 miles) to campus. Watch for signs to USI. As you enter USI the parking spaces will be on the left side, go to <u>parking Lot C</u> to park (no assigned parking spaces), you will have to walk up (small hill) the sidewalk to the University Center. Upon entering the University Center you can either take the steps or the elevator (on the right side) to the second floor, room UC 201 will be to your left.</p>
