Clinical simulation is an exciting and innovative way to enhance the education health care professionals for the future. Simulation provides training and feedback methods that allow learners to practice tasks, develop important skills, and learn procedures in life-like settings. Simulation technologies are revolutionizing health care education for students as well as seasoned practitioners. The techniques utilized can help to move health care from the "see one, do one, teach one" model to the "see one, practice many, do one" model of success. Just as pilot simulator training improved airline safety, by reducing errors, the use of clinical simulation for healthcare education can promote confidence, reduce errors, improve patient safety, and reduce overall health care costs.

The University of Southern Indiana College of Nursing and Health Professions established a Learning Resource Center (LRC) in 1988 utilizing standardized patients. The LRC was expanded to include a Clinical Simulation Center in 2006 with four high fidelity Human Patient Simulators (HPS). Since the inception of the center we have added an infant simulator and an adult wireless simulator. In addition, we have two audiovisual AV systems and two control rooms. We have invested in the training and education of dedicated Clinical Simulation faculty and staff from a variety of disciplines who have become experts in the development and management of our center. As we have grown we have found more and more hospitals, clinics, and education facilities are adding simulation to their training labs and are looking for help in getting off the ground and answering the difficult questions that come with newer technologies. We now offer our assistance to individuals, hospitals, clinics, educators, universities and other health care educators who would like direction in establishing or maintaining a clinical simulation center.

Our services include:

Clinical Simulation Certificate Program

This interactive Certificate Program is a four week, 32 hour continuing education program for clinical educators from all disciplines, clinical lab directors, faculty, nurses, pharmacists, physicians, physical and respiratory therapists, and other health care

professionals interested in gaining knowledge pertaining to clinical simulation. The focus of the program is on the introduction to simulation, types of simulation, creation of a high fidelity simulation laboratory, strategies and scenarios utilized for clinical simulation education, and outcomes measurement. The program consists of four modules. Each module contains reading assignments, an instructor outline, audio visual presentations, interactive learning components, and study guide questions. The course concludes with a comprehensive assessment of learning and a program evaluation. During the program learners interact with faculty who are expert in the area of clinical simulation. A certificate of completion is sent via email approximately two weeks following receipt of all course requirements. Nurses received 32 CEs for completion of the program. The program has been reviewed by local and national experts. The cost of this program is \$400 per person with discounts available if included in a package or for 3 or more registrations per facility.

Onsite Visits

We will send one of our clinical simulation teaching experts to you or we invite you to visit our center. The visits will include a 1-2 full day instruction, consultation, and advice on how to best establish or update your center.

Cost

\$500 per day plus expenses to visit our center.

\$750 per day for our faculty to visit you.

One year remote consultation

We will be available for your questions, concerns, and hurdles for a period of one year. You may call or email anytime and you will receive an answer within one business day. The cost is \$750 per year.

Ongoing networking

When you subscribe to any of the services above you are added to a communication network that provides a forum for discussion on simulation with our experts and others who have participated in our program. The network provides an opportunity for not only sharing your difficulties as well as what has worked for you but allows you to interact with clinical simulation professionals from around the county. This benefit never expires.

Customized consultation package

We will work with you to design a package of services that best meets your needs including extended help from our team or other services identified by your needs assessment in helping to establish your clinical simulation center as a center of excellence in education.
