This course will seek to provide students with an interdisciplinary outlook toward the 1960s as viewed from four decades later, through class discussion, video, guest speakers, and readings including Greene's *America in the Sixties*, Reeves' *President Kennedy: Profile of Power*, Tom Wolfe's *The Electric Kool Aid Acid Test*, Garrow's *Bearing the Cross: Martin Luther King and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference*, and Herr's *Dispatches*. Topics will include civil rights, the women's movement, government responsibility, the counterculture and the emergence of rock as a social phenomenon, and the Vietnam War and its legacy.
