

**COMMUNAL STUDIES ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE  
NEW HARMONY, INDIANA  
SEPTEMBER 30 – OCTOBER 2, 2010**

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Historic New Harmony was the site of two experiments in communal living in the first half of the nineteenth century. New Harmony is on Central Daylight Time.

**NEW HARMONY INN AND CONFERENCE CENTER:**

All points of interest are within easy walking distance from the New Harmony Inn, the conference hotel (<http://www.newharmonyinn.com/>). Rates are \$115 per night for the Riverbend building and \$135 per night for the Rosebank building. For reservations, call 1-800-782-8605 or 1-812-682-4431 ext. 1499. Breakfast is included with the room rate. Check-in at the New Harmony Inn is anytime after 3:00 p.m. Registration for the conference will be at the Conference Center. Free parking is available at the New Harmony Inn. We expect the conference hotel to fill up and we suggest you make reservations early. **ACCESS TO NEW HARMONY**

Historic New Harmony is located **30 minutes west of Evansville, Indiana**. Evansville Regional Airport serves Evansville. If you require shuttle service from Evansville, arrangements should be made two weeks prior to arrival and there is a \$50.00 fee for one-way service or \$100.00 for round-trip service. You may make shuttle arrangements by calling the New Harmony Inn, 800-782-8605 or 812-682-4491. Major car rental services are available at the airport and other locations in Evansville.

**Interstate 64** runs north of Historic New Harmony. Take **Exit 4** from Interstate 64, turn south on Highway 69. In about six miles there is a sign on the right indicating the turn to New Harmony. You will enter town on Church Street. At the one and only flashing light (corner of Church and Main Streets) turn right; go two blocks to North street, turn right on North Street. The Entry House of the New Harmony Inn (registration) is on the left, one block east on North Street at the intersection of Brewery and North Streets.

New Harmony is located on the Wabash River, which is the Indiana/Illinois state line. Distances from major cities in the area are:

Louisville, KY	Two Hours
St. Louis, MO	Two and one-half Hours
Nashville, TN	Three Hours
Indianapolis, IN	Three and one-half Hours
