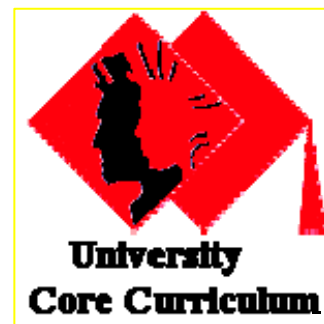

\*\*\* **Art students** may not take ART 201 for the Arts.

\*\*\*\* **English majors** are highly encouraged to take HUM 241 and 242, but not required to do so.
