Research Databases

"Databases" link on the library home page

Academic Search Premier (EBSCO)

From the advanced search page, search for "copyright" as a subject term and "fair use" and "digital" in default fields. Limit to scholarly publications and desired date range.

ERIC

From the advanced search page, search for "copyright" AND "fair use" AND "digital." Limit by "journals" as publication type.

Library, Information Science and Technology Abstracts

From the advanced search page, search for "copyright" and "fair use" and limit to peer-reviewed publications.
