Fall 2011 Move-In Schedule

Wednesday, August 17

Living Learning Community residents only can move in from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Follow the signs.

Thursday, August 18

Check-In for New Students ONLY

9 a.m.–3 p.m. Check-In at the Physical Activities Center

- Residents with the last name of A-L may begin arriving at 9 a.m.
- Residents with the last name of M-Z may begin arriving at 12:30 p.m.

3 p.m.–Midnight Check-In at the Housing and Residence Life Center

Friday-Sunday, August 19- 21

Check-in for all remaining residents

9 a.m.–5 p.m. Check-In at the following locations:

- Residence Hall residents – Newman Hall
- O’Daniel North and O’Daniel South residents – Residence Life Center
- McDonald East and McDonald West residents – Residence Life Community Center

5p.m.–Midnight Check-In at Housing and Residence Life Center



Where am I living and who is my roommate?

You should have selected your room in June as an incoming freshman and in March as a returning student. If you did not select a roommate and are rooming with new people, we strongly encourage you to contact your new roommates and ask questions that will help you get to know them better.

- When are they arriving at USI?
- What are they bringing?
- What kind of hobbies or interests do they have?

If you feel there has been an error in your roommate info, contact our office at 812/468-2000. Roommate changes will not take place until after the second week of classes, but we are happy to assist you and answer any questions you may have.

What if I've Been Approved to Arrive Early?

If you've been approved for early arrival, you will check in at the Housing and Residence Life Center at your appointed time.

All requests for early move-in should have been received in our office by 4:30 p.m. on August 1, 2011.

Early arrivals will not be allowed prior to Tuesday, August 16, 2011. Students trying to move in early without approval will be denied and asked to find alternative housing until their official move date.

Students approved for early move-in will be charged \$20 for each day prior to the official opening date. Meal plans will not be in effect until the published check-in date.

Those without approval from Housing and Residence Life will NOT be allowed to check-in early.

Where Can I Park?

Parking is always a big question. To help USI students understand about parking, the Department of Safety and Security would like to provide you with the following information:

- All housing residents are required to register their vehicle. You can register your vehicle online at <https://www.usi.edu/security/vehiclereg/>.
- Tickets will be issued for illegal parking and use of assigned parking spots (handicapped spots, authorized University vehicle spots, security vehicle spots, etc.)
- During Housing check-in, students may obtain their parking permits. Students must present their driver's license or Eagle Access Card to receive an official USI parking permit.
- During the first week of school, students may report to the Housing and Residence Life Center, bring their driver's license and vehicle registration and pick up their parking permit.
- Students living in University Housing may not drive their vehicles to campus between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m. on days that classes are in session. A campus shuttle is available to transport students to the main campus.
