10. **Late Arrivals:**

Only in round one games may late arrivals enter the competition. However, round one games will not be stopped or interrupted by late arrivals and all points and standings shall remain official. If game number one has been completed, the late arrivals will receive no points for game number one round one game. At the conclusion of Round one and two game and results are turned in to the scorers table, late arrivals will not be eligible to participate in the CO-ED Couples Competition.

♥ **No disruption of play, change of points or standings!**

11. **Forfeit Policy:**

♥ Registered couples requesting to enter the competition at the conclusion of Round one, and completion of Games one and two, the scores are reported, and a forfeit will be declared

12. **Game Format:**

♥ Three Rounds of games:

* Round One/Preliminary Round: February 18th, 2010- PAC Facility-- All registered couples will compete in round one. The preliminary round will include four games, and the top 12 winning couples will advance to round two.

* Round Two/Semifinal Round: February 21, 2010 - RFWC Facility-- the semi final round will include four games for the 12 winning couples from round number one. The top 6 winning couples will advance to the final round, round three.

* Round Three/Final Round: February 21, 2010 - RFWC Facility - The 6 winning couples from round number two will be competing in round three for an additional four games.

♥ In each round, the couples are guaranteed four games.

Position Placement Point System for Games

♥ **Round One:** The twelve couples advancing to round two will be determined by the accumulated position placement points received in round one.

♥ **Round Two:** The six couples advancing to round three/final round will be determined by the accumulated position placement points received in round two.

♥ **Round Three/Final Round:** The final position placement of the six couples in round three (final round) will be determined by the accumulated position placement points received in round two and three.

Cupid's Door Prizes

♥ **Cupid's Surprise** - At the conclusion of the preliminary Round One, the top 12 couples will be announced for the semi-final Round Two and the remaining couples are eligible for Cupid's surprise Door Prizes!! The couples' assigned contestant number will be placed in a heart basket and randomly drawn for the door prizes.

♥ **Cupid's Heart Prizes** - Cupid's Heart Prizes will be presented to the six eliminated Broken Heart couples in round two.

♥ **Cupid's Winning Couples** - Cupid's Winning Couples will receive fantastic prizes and awards for advancing to the top six positions. (Limousine ride, dinner for two at Rafferty's and a movie at Showplace Cinemas North.)

All Campus Points

♥ **Coed Division** : Points will be awarded to the participating teams. 1st- 150, 2nd- 125, 3rd-4th 100, 5th- 8th 75, Participation points - 25, Qualified for Round 2 - 50 points.

Game Tie Breaker

♥ If the score/time is tied at the end of the game, points will be split between the two couples (Ex: In Round One, A 1st place Tie - 150 points & 2nd place - 125 points, divide by 2 and each couple will be awarded 137.5 points).

End of Round Tie Breaker

♥ If there is a tie upon the completion of round one for the 12th place position, round two for the 6th place position, or the final round for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th place positions, the couples who are tied will play a thirty second free throw shooting game. Both individuals will shoot at separate courts and the score will be added together and presented to the scorekeeper. This game will break the tie. The couple who scores the most points will be awarded the placement points and position.
