Screaming Eagles Game Notes

- **Eagles still in control of their own destiny.** The Screaming Eagles are still in control of their own destiny despite their set back to Missouri S&T Saturday. USI needs just one win in its final two games to wrap up the third seed in the GLVC West Division and the last remaining spot in the GLVC Tournament. A Missouri S&T loss to Missouri-St. Louis Saturday also would ensure the Eagles a trip to the conference tournament.
- **Neuman doubling up the competition.** Senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman** has recorded three straight double-doubles and four double-doubles in the last five games. She is currently tied for second in the GLVC with seven double-doubles this year. Neuman, who leads the GLVC in scoring, has averaged a team-high 15.6 points and 9.7 rebounds in USI's last nine contests.

- **Newhart notches' career best.** Sophomore guard **Amie Newhart** scored a career-high 21 points in USI's setback to Missouri S&T. She has averaged 15.1 points per appearance in the Eagles' last nine outings and is currently 19th in the GLVC with a season scoring average of 11.8 points per game.
- **Historic rebounding effort.** Senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman's** 18 rebounds against Missouri-St. Louis was the highest rebounding total by a USI player since USI and GLVC Hall of Fame member LeAnn Freeland grabbed 19 boards against Indianapolis February 1, 1996.
- **Neuman needs three rebounds for 500.** Senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman** needs just three rebounds to become the 11th player in school history reach 500 in her career. Neuman is currently 11th all-time at USI in career rebounds, needing 45 to crack the top 10.
- **Williams notches another double-double.** Junior guard/forward **Abby Williams** recorded her second double-double in the last three games when she pulled down 13 points and 10 rebounds in USI's overtime victory over Missouri-St. Louis. She is second on the team with three double-doubles this season.
- **Young has big second half, overtime.** Sophomore guard **Ellen Young** scored 17 of her game-high 19 points in following the intermission in USI's overtime win against Missouri-St. Louis.
- **Meneghetti dishing the rock.** Sophomore guard **Lauren Meneghetti** has been racking up the assists in the last five outings, averaging 5.0 assists per game during that span. She had eight assists in USI's win over Drury and seven assists in USI's win over Missouri-St. Louis.
- **Stein is USI's all-time winningest coach.** Head Coach **Rick Stein** surpassed former Head Coach Chancellor Dugan for first place on the program's all-time wins list with USI's 80-75 victory over Wayne State (12/29/08). Stein, who has been a part in 326 victories during his stay at USI, has put up 167 victories in his nine-plus years at the helm of the USI women's basketball program. Stein reached his 100th career victory in just 151 games, making him the fastest coach in the program's history to accomplish that feat.
- **Seeing double.** Senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman** (7), sophomore guard **Ellen Young** (2), junior guard/forward **Abby Williams** (3), and senior forward/center **Ninette Evans** (1) have combined for 13 double-doubles in this season.
- **USI has had at least five players reach double figures five times in 2008-09.** At least five USI players reached double figures in the scoring column in five games this season. USI had five players reach double digits in its 79-55 victory over Mid-Continent and its 87-62 win over Grace. They had six players reach double figures in their 92-73 win over Missouri-St. Louis and five players reach double digits in their 79-75 win over Missouri S&T. USI also had five players reach double figures in its 94-75 victory over Lake Erie. The Eagles had only one game in 2007-08 in which five of their players recorded 10 or more points.
- **20-point plateau.** Sophomore guard **Lauren Meneghetti** (1), senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman** (3), sophomore guard **Amie Newhart** (1), freshman guard **Rinesha Soaper** (1), and sophomore guard **Ellen Young** (4) have combined for ten 20-point efforts this season.
- **Eagles ranked in the GLVC (as of a.m. 2/24/09).** The Eagles have six players ranked in 12 GLVC statistical categories:
Ninette Evans (2 categories) is sixth in offensive rebounds (2.64 orpg) and is 11th in blocks (0.68 bpg);
Brittany Neuman (5 categories) leads the GLVC in total rebounding (8.3 rpg), is third in field goal percentage (.550), is tied for third in offensive rebounds (3.48 orpg), is sixth in defensive rebounds (4.80 drpg), and is seventh in blocks (0.84 bpg);
Amie Newhart (5 categories) is fifth in three-point field goal percentage (.439), is tied for eighth in minutes played (32.00 mppg), is 12th in free throw percentage (.824), is 14th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.10), and is 19th in scoring (11.8 ppg);
Rinesha Soaper (1 category) is seventh in steals (1.96 spg);
Abby Williams (1 category) is 18th in total rebounding (5.7 rpg).
Ellen Young (4 categories) is fifth in minutes played (32.44 mppg), is tied for 10th in steals (1.76 spg), is 12th in scoring (13.7 ppg), and is 15th in free throw percentage (.786).
- **Neuman earns GLVC Player of the Week honors.** Senior forward/center **Brittany Neuman** was named the GLVC Player of the Week for her performance against Edinboro. Neuman, who was 9-of-11 from the floor and 6-of-6 from the free throw line, finished the game with a career-high 24 points and 13 rebounds as the Eagles defeated the Fighting Scots, 88-80.
- **Magic Mark: 75 points.** The Eagles have won 83 of their last 94 games when scoring at least 75 points. USI is 183-18 (.911) since 1996-97 when reaching the 75-point plateau.
