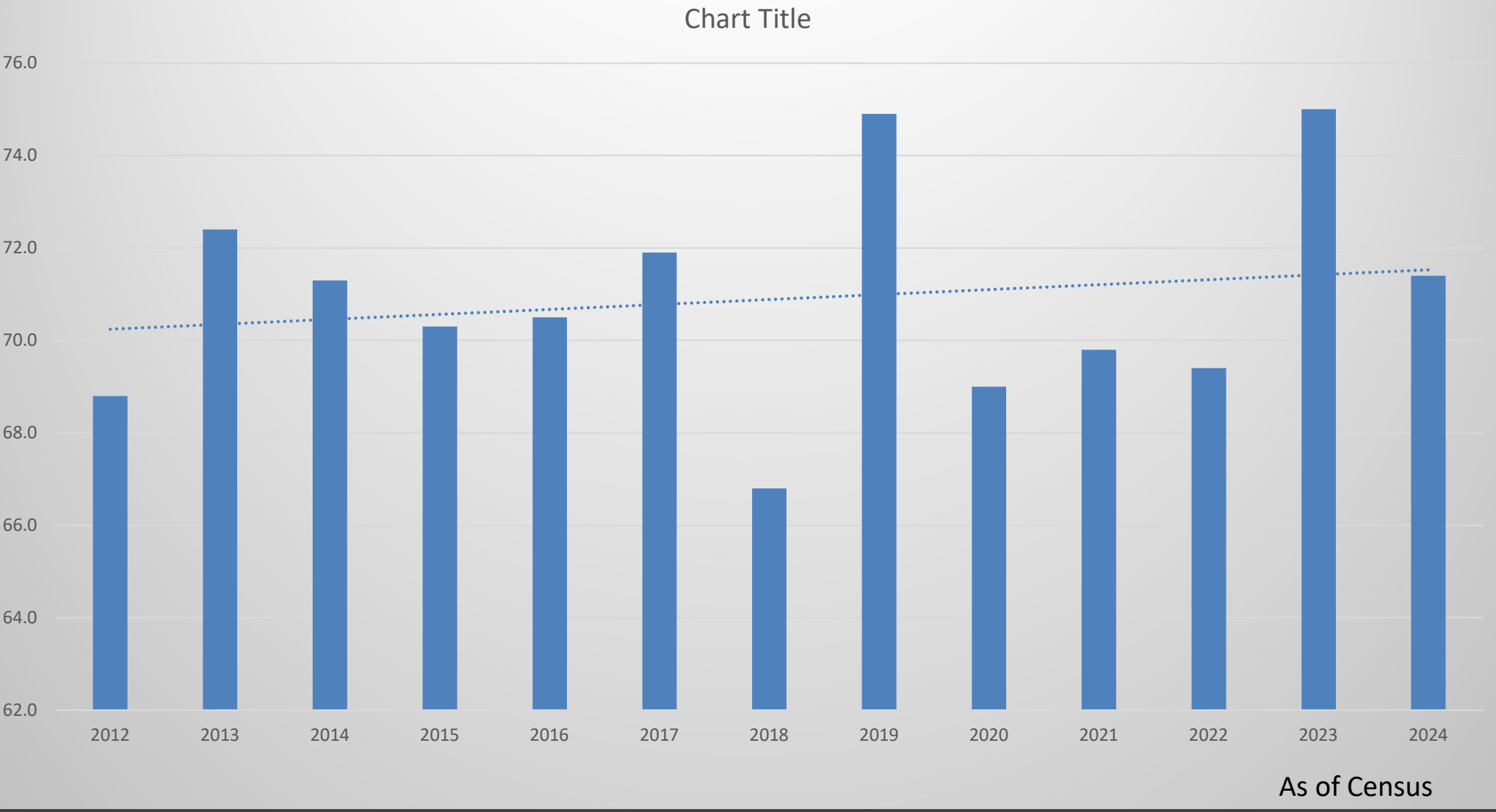

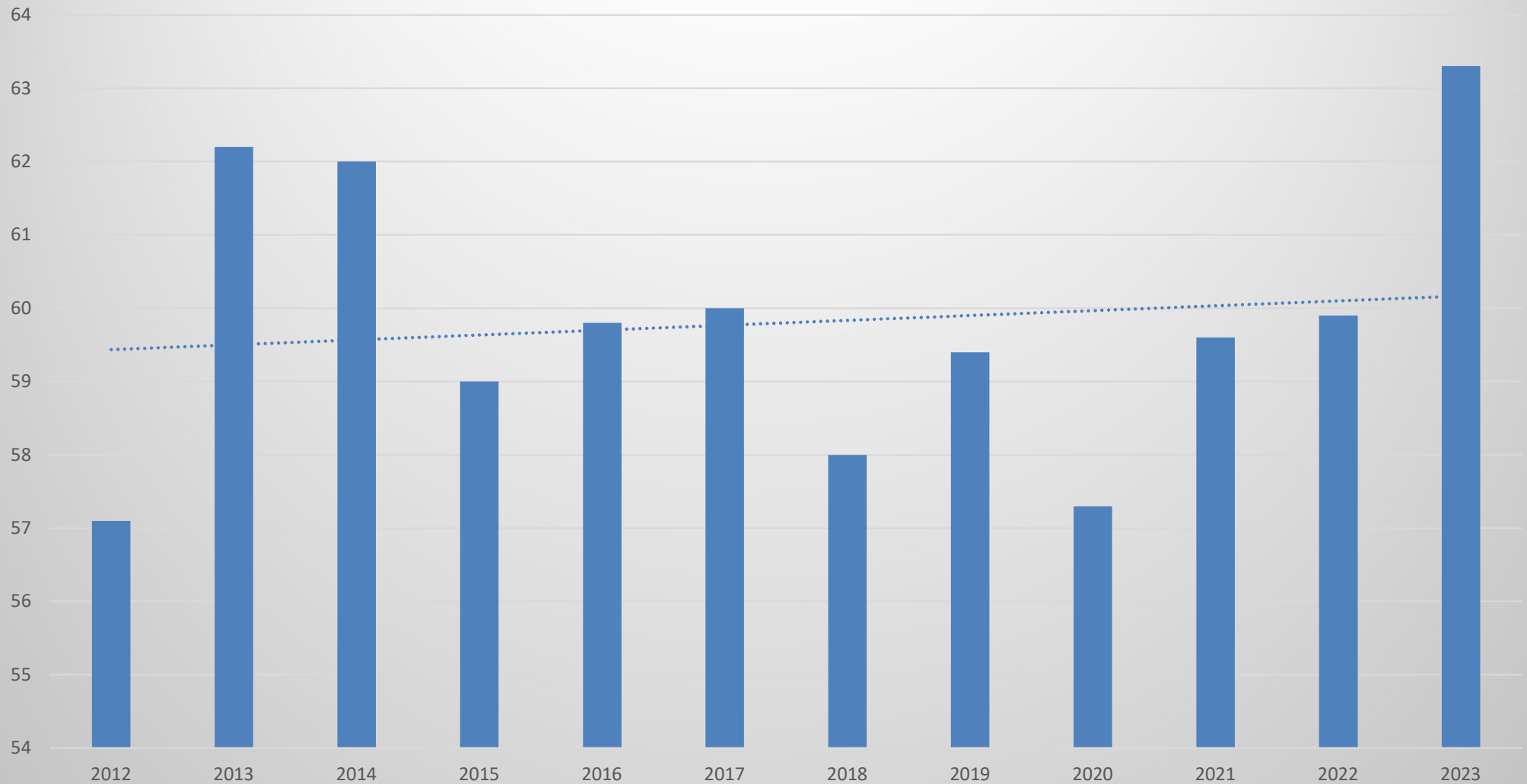

# Undergraduate Students Not Enrolled for Fall 2025

- 70 Student Athletes did not enroll for Fall 2025
  - 23 student athletes were first year students (1.8%)
- 331 students owed a balance
  - 131 were freshmen (10.1%)
- 100 students academically dismissed
  - 52 students were freshmen (4.0%)
- Students who were test-optional are less likely to be retained
  - Retention rates are 9.5 - 14.1% lower over last four years
