Highlights

- CAPS received full IACS Accreditation Fall 2025
- CAPS currently has 3 positions open (2 clinical & 1 admin)

# Pathways to USI & TRIO Student Support Services

## *Pathways to USI*

- With an impressive retention rate from the summer bridge program to successful full-time credit enrollment past the critical first year of college (84%) and beyond (78%), Pathways to USI will continue to focus on the research backed student-centered work that they do well.

- The 2026 five-week residential Pre-Screagles Summer Institute (PSSI) will continue to support newly admitted first-year students by strengthening the admissions pipeline, easing the transition to college, and promoting holistic student success through high-touch, one-on-one coaching. Pathways to USI will expand its capacity and campus presence while aligning services with CAS and NACADA standards to better meet student needs.

## *TRIO SSS*

- January 5 marks the official transition of TRIO SSS to reporting under Student Affairs.
- The program is currently operating at 87% capacity and will continue recruiting throughout the spring, with a goal of reaching full capacity (140 students) by March 2026.
- Four students graduated in December 2025, with an anticipated 20+ graduates in Spring 2026.
