

UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

March 3, 2005

The University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees met in regular session on Thursday, March 3, 2005, in the University Center. Present were Chair J. David Huber and Trustees Bruce H. Baker, Louise S. Bruce, Mark A. Day, G. Patrick Hoehn, Frank F. McDonald II, Harolyn G. Torain, Samuel J. Tucker, and James L. Will Sr. Also in attendance were President H. Ray Hoops; Vice President for Governmental Relations Cynthia S. Brinker; Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs M. Edward Jones; Vice President for Student Affairs Robert W. Parrent; Vice President for Business Affairs Mark Rozewski; Vice President for Advancement Sherrianne M. Standley; Faculty Senate Chair Mark Krahling; and Student Government Association President Eric Sharp.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 1:40 p.m.

Chair Huber began the meeting by welcoming Vice President Mark Rozewski to his first Board of Trustees meeting and welcomed Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs Ed Jones to the board table in the absence of Provost Linda Bennett.

SECTION I - GENERAL AND ACADEMIC MATTERS

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JANUARY 13, 2005, MEETING

On a motion by Mr. Hoehn, seconded by Mr. Baker, the minutes of the January 10, 2005, meeting were approved.

B. ESTABLISHMENT OF NEXT MEETING DATE, TIME, LOCATION

The next regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was set for Saturday, May 7, 2005, on campus.

C. REPORT OF THE LONG-RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Long-Range Planning Committee met prior to the Board of Trustees meeting on March 3, 2005. Mr. Huber called on Mr. Baker, chair of the Long-Range Planning Committee, for a report. Mr. Baker reported that the committee heard four reports about USI's economic development initiatives. The reports included information on the economic impact of Toyota Motor Manufacturing Indiana (TMMI) on the region; the creation of the Center for Bone and Joint Care, a cooperative effort of USI, Deaconess Hospital, and Orthopaedic Associates; Extended Services' role in organizing and providing training for the Tri-State Industrial Safety Council; and innovative and customized master's programs in the School of Science and Engineering that were developed in response to organizational needs.

D. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Hoops began his report by thanking the trustees for their participation, prior to the meeting, in the "topping-out" ceremony for the Rice Library project. He reported that the University has commissioned art professors Katie Waters and John McNaughton to create artwork which will be installed 40 feet above the main entrance to the library. The artwork has been completed and the artisans at Evans Limestone Company in Bedford, Indiana, are now executing the carvings. He expressed appreciation for the generous gift of Dorothea Schlechte which made this addition to the library possible.

Dr. Hoops asked Dr. Jones to introduce the team of USI accounting students that captured first place in the 2004 Indiana CPA Case Competition. Dr. Jones called on faculty advisor Ms. Jeanette Maier-Lytte, who introduced two members of the winning team, Donovan Sexton and Jamie Willis. Other members were Scott Dennis and Brad Hotz. Mr. Donovan and Ms. Willis reported on the competition, in which nine Indiana colleges

F. APPROVAL OF AMENDED SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT

Mr. Huber called on Vice President Rozewski to review the requested approval of an amended sanitary sewer easement. Mr. Rozewski explained that, at its meeting on January 13, 2005, the Board of Trustees, upon the recommendation of the Construction Committee, approved the request for an easement for right-of-way along the east side of Schutte Road from Mahrenholz Drive to Clarke Lane. The easement will be used to install a sanitary sewer pipe for connection to the existing gravity flow sanitary sewer on Clarke Lane to serve the development at the southeast corner of Schutte Road and State Highway 62. The request was approved pending the addition of language in the easement document that any utility using the easement will maintain and return the property to its original condition upon completion of the installation. The document was approved by the chair, signed, and notarized.

Mr. Rozewski noted that the University has since learned the original document, prepared by the engineering firm, indicated that Vanderburgh County would be the grantee for a public utility easement, when the grantee should have been the Evansville Water and Sewer Utility Department for a sanitary sewer easement. Following the recommendation of the Construction Committee, Mr. Rozewski recommended that the Board amend its original approval by approving the amended easement document in Exhibit I-B.

On a motion by Mr. Tucker, seconded by Mr. Baker, the amended easement document in Exhibit I-B was approved.

G. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES

Chair Huber called on Dr. Jones to review the candidates for degrees. Dr. Jones referred the trustees to Exhibit I-C, a list of the candidates for master, baccalaureate, and associate degrees to be conferred May 8, 2005, and recommended that award of the respective degrees be approved subject to the completion of all requirements.

On a motion by Mrs. Torain, seconded by Mr. Will, award of the degrees in Exhibit I-C was approved subject to the completion of all requirements.

H. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATE FOR HONORARY DEGREE

Chair Huber called on Vice President Standley, who reported that Mr. Charles Huppert will bring the Commencement address and recommended that an honorary degree be conferred upon him during the Commencement ceremony on May 8, 2005.

On a motion by Mr. Hoehn, seconded by Mr. Tucker, the following honorary degree was approved.

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE to Charles Huppert, Evansville businessman and World War II pilot who, as a prisoner of war, helped engineer "The Great Escape" from the notorious Zagan, Poland, POW camp.

I. APPOINTMENT OF TREASURER

Mr. Huber asked President Hoops to report on the appointment of the treasurer. Dr. Hoops recommended that Mark Rozewski, who was named Vice President for Business Affairs effective February 28, 2005, be appointed as Treasurer, retroactive to February 28, 2005.

On a motion by Mr. Hoehn, seconded by Mr. Baker, the appointment of Mark Rozewski as Treasurer, retroactive to February 28, 2005, was approved.

SECTION II – FINANCIAL MATTERS

A. REPORT OF THE FINANCE/AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Finance/Audit Committee met in joint session with the Construction Committee prior to the Board of Trustees meeting on March 3, 2005. Chair Pat Hoehn reported that the committee heard a report from the Internal Audit Department about recently completed audits and the Audit Plan for 2005-2006. The committee also heard a report about the implementation of a fraud hotline and approved budget appropriations, adjustments, and transfers.

B. REPORT OF THE CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE

The Construction Committee met in joint session with the Finance/Audit Committee prior to the Board of Trustees meeting on March 3, 2005. Chair Pat Hoehn reported that the committee heard a report on change orders for the Rice Library project and approved a recommendation to the Board of Trustees for approval of the easement in Section I, Item F.

C. UPDATE ON CURRENT CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Chair Huber called on Mr. Rozewski, who introduced Director of Facilities Operations and Planning Steve Helfrich for a report of current construction projects. Mr. Helfrich reported that the erection of the structural steel columns and beams in the David L. Rice Library project is complete and that other work on the project is progressing as scheduled.

He reported on two other projects associated with the operation of the new library. The University is upgrading the 12.5kv electric distribution system in the utility tunnels and installing the electrical feed to the library building. This work, approximately 70 percent complete, is required to integrate the library into the campus electrical loop distribution system. The other project is to replace the oldest centrifugal chiller for cooling the campus buildings with a new chiller. Work on this project is expected to be complete in July, 2005.

Mr. Helfrich reported that the lake dam near the residence halls is 95 percent complete and the lake is being filled with water. Improvements around the lake, including walking and hiking trails, fishing site improvements, lighting, and other amenities will be completed later this year. The University will work with the Indiana Department of Natural Resources to stock the lake with fish.

He reported that construction work to make improvements to the parking area to the west of the University Center is scheduled to begin soon. The project will include the installation of a parking attendant booth at the entrance to the parking area at Bent Twig Lane so the existing parking spaces can be reserved for guests who attend events in the University Center.

Projects scheduled for spring and summer include the renovation of the upper level of the Forum Wing of the Wright Administration Building to provide space for the Human Resources Department, the Travel Office, and the English as a Second Language Institute (ESLI); Phase III of the Schnee Ribeyre Elliott House in New Harmony; replacement of roofs on six buildings in the O'Daniel South student housing complex; and replacement of the east half of the clay tile roof on Murphy Auditorium in New Harmony.

SECTION III – PERSONNEL MATTERS

A. APPROVAL OF ANNUAL AUTHORIZATION FOR EMPLOYMENT OF FACULTY AND STAFF

Mr. Huber called on Vice President Rozewski, who reported that the University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees, pursuant to Indiana Code 20-12-1-4, annually authorizes the President of the University of Southern Indiana to employ faculty and staff and to establish salaries and wages within budgetary capabilities. The last authorization was on March 4, 2004.

On a motion by Mr. Tucker, seconded by Mr. Will, the Board of Trustees authorized the President of the University to employ qualified faculty and staff, to grant leaves of absence, and to establish salaries, wages, and benefits for employees within the capabilities of the budget and authorized the Chair of the Board of Trustees to convey to the President his employment contract, including salary and benefits.

B. APPROVAL OF PERSONNEL ACTIONS

On a motion by Mr. Baker, seconded by Mr. Will, the Continuous Appointments (Item 1.) and Promotions (Item 2.) were approved.

On a motion by Mr. Hoehn, seconded by Mrs. Torain, the Early Retirement (Item 3.), Retirement (Item 4.), and Emeritus/Emerita Status (Item 5.) were approved.

5. Emeritus/Emerita Status




