UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

March 2, 2023

The University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees met on Thursday, March 2, 2023, in the Griffin Center on campus. Present were Chair Ronald D. Romain '73 and Trustees W. Harold Calloway; John M. Dunn; Daniel M. Fuquay; Christine H. Keck; Jeffrey L. Knight; Christina M. Ryan and Kenneth L. Sendelweck '76. Trustee Liam H. Collins '23 was absent. Also in attendance were President Ronald S. Rochon; Provost Mohammed Khayum; Vice President for Finance and Administration Steven J. Bridges '89 M'95; Vice President for Marketing and Communication Kindra L. Strupp M'22; Vice President for Development David A. Bower; Vice President for Student Affairs Khalilah Doss; Vice President for Strategic Enrollment Management Troy A. Miller; Chief Government and Legal Affairs Officer Aaron C. Trump; Faculty Senate Chair Kimberly J. Delaney and Student Government Association President Taegan B. Garner '23.

Chair Romain called the meeting to order at 10:37 a.m.

SECTION I – GENERAL AND ACADEMIC MATTERS

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JANUARY 17, 2023, MEETING

On a motion by Mr. Knight, seconded by Mr. Sendelweck, the minutes of the January 17, 2023, meeting of the Board of Trustees were approved.

B. ESTABLISHMENT OF NEXT MEETING DATE AND LOCATION

Mr. Romain called on Vice President Strupp, who reported the next meeting of the Board of Trustees is scheduled for Friday, May 5, 2023, on campus in the Griffin Center.

C. APPOINTMENT OF THE PRESIDENTIAL COMPENSATION AND EVALUATION COMMITTEE

Chair Romain stated that according to Article V, Section 3, Subsection (b) of the bylaws, the Presidential Compensation and Evaluation Committee is appointed annually by the Chair of the Board at the March meeting of the Board of Trustees. Accordingly, he appointed Christine Keck, Christina Ryan, Daniel Fuquay and Liam Collins to serve on this committee.

D. REPORT OF THE ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AND ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

Mr. Romain called on Trustee Ryan for a report from the Academic Affairs and Enrollment Management Committee. Ms. Ryan reported the committee met prior to the Board of Trustees meeting and heard an Academic Affairs update from Provost Khayum that included information on the Indiana College Core which is a block of 30 credit hours of college-level coursework offered to high school seniors that includes specific competencies and learning outcomes commonly found in general education programs. Additionally, Dr. Shelly Blunt presented an overview of USI's new customer relationship management platform, Slate. She highlighted its capabilities and features and reviewed how the software will be used to assist USI with recruitment and retention efforts.

E. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Chair Romain called on President Rochon for a report. President Rochon began by introducing and welcoming Mr. Troy A. Miller, Vice President for Strategic Enrollment Management, to his first Board of Trustees meeting. Mr. Miller will officially be on campus beginning April 3, 2023.

The University of Southern Indiana Men's and Women's Swimming & Diving were named to the College Swimming & Diving Coaches Association of America Fall 2022 Scholar All-America Teams. The Women were one of 188 teams to earn the honor while the Men were one of 121 schools. The Screaming Eagles were one of nine schools to earn the award for the first time this season and were the lone NCAA Division I first-time winners in the program's first season.

It was a special day on campus Wednesday, February 15, when more than 365 high school students visited USI to learn more about the education profession at our “Be a Teacher” event. Students had the opportunity to learn about the USI Teacher Education program and its offerings; interact with a preschool (P) through grade 12 education panel comprised of local professionals, including Dr. David Smith, Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation Superintendent and Matt Thompson, Superintendent MSD of Mount Vernon; participate in a classroom experience; and tour the Education Center. This successful event garnered the attention of the Indiana State Board of Education. USI is now in discussions with Dr. Katie Jenner, IN Secretary of Education and Chris Lowery, IN Commissioner for Higher Education to model and scale this event for all universities across the state.

USI Softball traveled across town to open its first season in Division I competition on Saturday, February 18. The team participated in the Evansville Invitational Classic at Cooper Stadium at the University of Evansville. USI's first game was a win against Green Bay. The women went on to play against Green Bay again on Sunday with another win. Then later that day lost by one run after a nine-inning game against UE.

USI Baseball kicked off its Division I play during a four-game series against Western Illinois Friday, February 17 through Sunday, February 19. The series opened on Friday with a win for USI, followed by a doubleheader on Saturday (one win one loss) and a single game on Sunday, another win.

The MAC/Pace Art Gallery is currently exhibiting “A Decade of Opportunity: Celebrating 10 Years of the Efroymsen Bridge Year Fellowship,” featuring works from the first 10 recipients of the Fellowship. The exhibition is on display through March 17. The Fellowship is a competitive award program that provides motivated and talented graduates of USI's Art and Design department with the opportunity to develop a strong portfolio in preparation for graduate study, as well as hone the skills and resources needed to establish a career in the visual arts. All past fellows are still active in their professional practice of creating unique work.

The University of Southern Indiana Tri-State Science and Engineering Fair will celebrate its 15th year on Thursday, March 9 in Carter Hall. Over 150 local K-12 students will showcase their science and engineering projects to judges comprised of over 50 USI faculty, staff, and area STEM professionals with an opportunity to receive community recognition, trophies, and cash prizes for their achievements. Grand Award winners will be selected to advance to the Hoosier Science and Engineering Fair in Indianapolis on March 18. There, students will compete for awards and the honor of representing Indiana at the Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair in May.

March is Disability Awareness Month and to honor this, USI Disability Resources, the ADA Coordinator and the Institutional Equity Office will host a week full of events, beginning March 13. These events will include a keynote presentation by Lizzie Velasquez, global motivational speaker, YouTube personality and anti-bullying activist/author at 6 p.m. on March 16 in Carter Hall. Dr. Rochon encouraged those who are not able to attend to research Ms. Velasquez online. Being identified one time as the “ugliest woman on earth,” her story of bravery in overcoming the many obstacles in life her disability presented to her is truly inspirational.

President Rochon called on Vice President Strupp for a report on Spring 2023 Commencement. Ms. Strupp announced the Commencement ceremonies will be held in the Screaming Eagles Arena on Friday, May 5 and Saturday, May 6. At this time, guest tickets will not be necessary. As of March 1, 2023, 1,523 students are eligible to graduate. USI will have notable USI alumni as the Commencement speakers across the five ceremonies.

Ms. Strupp provided a rundown of the weekend's activities. On Friday, May 5 Board of Trustees will meet in Griffin Center that afternoon and the first Commencement ceremony, the Graduate Ceremony will follow at 5 p.m. in the Screaming Eagles Arena. The first alumna to deliver the keynote Commencement address will be Matthew S. Keener '05, MBA'12, President of Keener Marketing Solutions, LLC.

On Saturday, May 6, there are four ceremonies with the first beginning at 9 a.m. for the College of Liberal Arts. Mr. Virgilio E. Paulino '18, Manager of Data Management, Sharing and Privacy at Capital One, will deliver the Commencement address. The Romain College of Business ceremony begins at noon, with Mr. Jared R. McIntosh '11, Vice President of Business Banking Relationship Management at Fifth Third Bank, to deliver the Commencement address. The College of Nursing and Health Professions ceremony begins at 3 p.m. Col. Connie L. Winik M'08, DNP'17, Chief Nurse, 959th Medical Group, United States Air Force, will deliver the address at this ceremony. And finally, the Pott College of Science, Engineering, and Education ceremony begins at 6 p.m., with our final speaker being Ms. Breasha L. Pruitt '08, Coach and Owner of Breasha Pruitt Elite Gymnastics.

Vice President Strupp directed members of the Board to a sign-up sheet in their packets. USI is requesting three Board members participate in each of the ceremonies.

Vice President Strupp introduced Claire Bosma, Chief Marketing Officer, and newest member of University Strategic Marketing, to the body.

President Rochon called on Provost Khayum for an update from Academic Affairs. Dr. Khayum reported as a result of the review process involved in the data collection and analysis of the decisions made by the University Promotions Committee, Faculty Senate approved a number of changes that impact the Promotions Committee, which is a standing committee under the faculty handbook section. These changes will not alter the role or responsibilities of the academic deans, the Provost's Office, nor the President's Office in regard to promotion and tenure. Since the Promotions Committee is a standing committee of the Faculty Senate under the bylaws of the Faculty Constitution, Dr. Kim Delaney, Faculty Senate Chair, will provide the context and details of these changes when she presents her Faculty Senate Report.

President Rochon called on Dr. Kim Delaney for a report from Faculty Senate. Faculty Senate continuously reviews the Faculty Constitution. Specifically, in the last two years Senate has considered the role of the University Promotions Committee and the associated standing charge for this committee in our Faculty Senate Bylaws. Upon suggestions from committee members themselves, Senate requested data from Provost Khayum regarding the role this committee plays in promotion and tenure decisions at the University of Southern Indiana. Dr. Delaney thanked Provost Khayum on behalf of the faculty for his strong support of this effort in collecting de-identified data to help investigate the role and scope of this important committee. Senate considered that this group of 8 individuals reviews 18-20 promotion and/or tenure applications annually. In previous decades this number was closer to 10 applications. Further, consideration was given to the frequency with which University Promotion Committee decisions played a deciding role in an application for promotion and/or tenure. Following all established processes for modification of the Faculty Senate bylaws, the body voted unanimously to modify the standing charge of this subcommittee. The new scope of this committee will be to consider applications for any individual that received non-unanimous recommendations from earlier levels of review (department committee, college committee, department chair, and/or dean or director). Furthermore, any applicant may request a review by the University Promotion Committee. This new policy will result in the committee reviewing an estimated 1-3 applications annually. The reduced workload will allow for a more thorough and focused review of each relevant application, allowing a well-researched and thoroughly considered recommendation from the University Promotion Committee to contribute to the recommendation made by the provost and the ultimate decision made by this body. Senate appreciates the support of President Rochon and Provost Khayum as they have undertaken this important task with diligence and thoughtfulness.

Dr. Delaney concluded her report by noting the Senate has also been considering charges regarding the implementation of Archie's Book Bundle and a report from its ad hoc committee on the process for application of merit pay raises. Senate is currently considering the recommendations of this ad hoc committee and plans to engage with the administration to propose ways it can ensure clear expectations and practices for the distribution of merit pay raises. It is the goal that USI faculty can have a clear understanding of processes and expectations so they may continue to excel within their fields and in their classrooms.

President Rochon called on Student Government Association (SGA) President Taegan Garner for a report. In February, SGA hosted Vanderburgh County Prosecutor Diane Moers for Crime Prevention Week. Students asked Prosecutor Moers questions about her courtroom experiences and how her office keeps Vanderburgh County safe. SGA also collaborated with the Activities Programming Board to show the movie *Knives Out* to close the week. Ms. Garner recognized student Tommy Kautzman for organizing those events.

Student Organization and Club President's Council (SOC President's Council) met to discuss issues that affect their groups on campus. Student leaders discussed catering costs, marketing restrictions, and the approval process for their clubs and organizations. Additionally, students provided thoughts on technology, Wi-Fi, food options, student worker experiences, and other general issues on campus. Ms. Garner will be meeting with departments across campus to discuss these issues and explore possible solutions. SGA is planning to host group meetings with all of its constituencies, to gain additional feedback across campus.

Ms. Garner concluded her report by noting several current events including:

- SGA will be collaborating with the Multicultural Center to show the movie *Till*. This movie was produced by this year's MLK speaker Keith Beauchamp.
- Academic Affairs is hosting donuts and degree work to help students prepare for priority registration.

- SGA's EDI committee is working with Gender and Sexuality Resources to put on a series of drag events.
- Student Trustee applications are now open. The selection committee has been formed and has met to discuss the timeline for the process.
- The term is ending for SGA which means elections will be coming soon. Applications to run for Student Government Association opened on March 1.

President Rochon concluded his report by recognizing two Trustees who recently celebrated birthdays. Mr. John Dunn celebrated his 85th birthday on February 25, and Mr. Harold Calloway celebrated his 77th birthday on February 27.

F. REPORT ON THE INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Mr. Romain called on Chief Government and Legal Affairs Officer Aaron Trump for a report on the 2023 session of the Indiana General Assembly. Mr. Trump began by explaining Government Affairs, along with the President's Office and Finance and Administration have been working on USI's biennial budget process since last summer. USI has now moved far through the process with only a few significant steps remaining, with the next being the University's presentation to the Senate Appropriations Committee on Tuesday, March 7. At this point, USI is pleased with where we stand following the publication of the House budget last week and we are optimistic for a positive outcome at the close of session in 8 weeks. One major factor in how positive that outcome will be is the announcement of the final revenue forecast, expected to be released the week of April 16.

The House and Senate completed their work for the first half of the legislative session this week, with third readings of bills on Monday and Tuesday, respectively. Bills that did not receive a third reading or did not receive a majority vote on third reading, are now considered dead bills for the 2023 legislative session. During the first half of the session, the General Assembly successfully moved 352 total bills, out of a possible 1,165 bills filed. Of the 147 bills USI has been following, 62 of those successfully advanced. These bills include the biennial budget, filed as House Bill 1001, as well as:

- House Bill 1002: EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE MATTERS: Establishes a career scholarship account program fund (CSA program fund); designate and approve modern youth apprenticeships programs, and programs of study leading to industry-recognized credentials; and determine the grant amount that a career scholarship student may receive under the CSA program fund for each sequence, course, apprenticeship, or program.
- House Bill 1343 REVIEW OF OCCUPATIONAL REGULATIONS: Provides that all occupational regulations must be limited to those demonstrably necessary and carefully tailored to fulfill legitimate public health, safety, or welfare objectives. Requires each public agency to conduct a review of all occupational regulations within the public agency's jurisdiction.
- Senate Bill 167: FAFSA: Requires all students in the student's senior year to complete and submit the FAFSA unless a parent or guardian of a student submits a waiver.
- Senate Bill 404: ACCESS TO TRANSCRIPTS: Provides that a state educational institution may not refuse to provide a transcript for a current or former student of the institution on the grounds that the student owes a debt to the institution or withhold from a current or former student's transcript any degrees earned on the grounds that the student owes a debt to the institution; if the student has paid certain amounts in the past year on the debt owed.
- Senate Bill 435: 21ST CENTURY SCHOLARS PROGRAM ENROLLMENT: Provides that the commission for higher education and the department of education shall identify income-eligible students for automatic enrollment in the twenty-first century scholars program.

G. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

Chair Romain called on Provost Khayum, who referred the Trustees to Exhibit I-A, a list of candidates for doctoral, master's, bachelor's and associate degrees, and certificates to be conferred May 5 and 6, 2023, and recommended approval of the degrees subject to the completion of all requirements.

On a motion by Mr. Knight, seconded by Ms. Ryan, the award of the degrees in Exhibit I-A, subject to the completion of all requirements, was approved.

H. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES

Chair Romain called on President Rochon who read from the USI Honorary Degree Policy, "An honorary degree from the University of Southern Indiana is the highest form of recognition granted by the institution. Individuals who have given distinguished and extraordinary service consistent with the mission of the University are eligible for consideration. That service may be to the University itself, and/or to local, statewide, national, or international communities. Individuals selected to receive an honorary degree should exemplify the highest ideals of integrity, service, and dedication to learning."

In accordance with the policy, President Rochon recommended the conferral of the following honorary degrees on Friday, May 5, 2023, be approved as follows:

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE to Marlene V. Shaw, PhD, Professor Emerita of Biology who served the University with distinction from 1973 until her retirement in 2009. Dr. Shaw continues to serve the University and community through the annual Shaw Biology Lecture, bringing scientific scholars to campus for the benefit of USI students and all who attend.

DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS to Richard H. Hunt, a world-renowned artist from Chicago who has been a sculptor for over 50 years. Mr. Hunt's work From Our Past Toward Our Future, a gift from the late James A. Sanders to the University in 2015 in celebration of the 50th anniversary of our founding, graces the campus quadrangle.

On a motion by Ms. Keck, seconded by Mr. Calloway, the honorary degrees were approved.

SECTION II – FINANCIAL MATTERS

A. REPORT OF THE FINANCE/AUDIT COMMITTEE MEETING

Chair Romain called on Finance/Audit Committee Chair Christine Keck for a report. The Finance/Audit Committee met prior to the Board of Trustees meeting and reviewed the audits completed by the Internal Audit Department in 2022 and approved the 2023 Annual Audit Plan. Additionally, the committee reviewed the construction change orders approved by the Vice President for Finance and Administration that were below the \$50,000 threshold for Board approval. Lastly, the committee heard an update from Neil Hepler, Co-President of Fourth Street Performance Partners regarding University investments.

B. REPORT ON CURRENT CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Mr. Romain called on Vice President Bridges, who introduced Director of Facility Operations and Planning Jim Wolfe for a report on the status of current construction projects. He referred the Trustees to Exhibit II-A for a list of projects and a summary of the cost and funding sources for each project.

SECTION III – PERSONNEL MATTERS

A. APPROVAL OF ANNUAL AUTHORIZATION FOR EMPLOYMENT OF FACULTY AND STAFF

Chair Romain called on Vice President Bridges who stated the University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees, pursuant to Indiana Code 21-38-3-2 and 21-38-3-9, annually authorizes the President of the University of Southern Indiana to employ faculty and staff, and to establish salaries, and wages within budgetary capabilities. The last authorization was on March 3, 2022. Approval today allows USI to continue this critical function.

On a motion by Ms. Ryan, seconded by Mr. Sendelweck, the annual authorization for employment of faculty and staff was approved.


D. APPROVAL OF EMERITA STATUS
