

#### MINUTES

### UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

#### March 5, 1992

The University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees met on Thursday, March 5, 1992, in the University Center, Room 353. Present were Trustees Bruce Baker, Percy Clark, Charles Combs, J. David Huber, Thomas McKenna, Kristel Swan, Robert Swan, and Harolyn Torain. Also attending were President David Rice; Vice Presidents Donald Bennett, Robert Reid, Sherrianne Standley, and Byron Wright; Faculty Senate Chairperson David Kinsey; and Indiana Commission for Higher Education members Pat Hoehn and P.A. Mack.

There being a quorum present, Mr. Baker called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

He welcomed Mr. Pat Hoehn and Mr. P.A. Mack, members of the Indiana Commission for Higher Education attending the meeting. Mr. Baker also reported that Chairman O'Daniel is progressing well following heart surgery.

## **SECTION I - GENERAL AND ACADEMIC MATTERS**

#### A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JANUARY 9, 1992, MEETING

On a motion by Mr. Combs, seconded by Mr. Swan, the minutes of the January 9, 1992, meeting were approved.

#### B. ESTABLISHMENT OF NEXT MEETING DATE, TIME, LOCATION

The next regular meeting of the Board was set for Saturday, May 9, at the University of Southern Indiana.

#### C. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Rice called on University legislative representative Cynthia Newhouse to present a summary of legislation introduced and enacted in the 1992 General Assembly. Discussion followed on several bills that were related to higher education.

Dr. Rice called on Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs Sandra Singer to report on academic data, including actual and projected enrollment, state appropriation per FTE student, instruction by full-time faculty, and projected enrollment and space needs. Discussion continued on the University's enrollment trends. Mr. McKenna expressed concern about the number of the University's part-time faculty and inquired about the number of part-time faculty at other institutions.

Dr. Rice called on Mr. Wright to report on the University's annual, biennial and capital budget requests. Mr. Wright said that the annual operating budget will be presented to the Board in May.

#### D. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES

The candidates for master, baccalaureate, and associate degrees, to be conferred May 9, 1992, are listed in Exhibit I-A.

On a motion by Mr. Swan, seconded by Mrs. Torain, award of the respective degrees was <u>approved</u> subject to the completion of all requirements.

#### E. APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES

On a motion by Mr. McKenna, seconded by Mrs. Torain, conferral of the following honorary degrees at the May 9, 1992, Commencement was approved.

**Doctor of Laws** to William A. Koch, developer of Holiday World, who has given leadership to economic and tourism development in southern Indiana.

**Doctor of Laws** to Bettye B. McCutchan, civic leader and long-time officer of University of Southern Indiana Foundation Board.

**Doctor of Laws** to George B. Weathersby, Partner, Founders Court, Princeton, New Jersey, and former Commissioner of Higher Education for Indiana. He will bring the Commencement Address.

#### SECTION II - FINANCIAL MATTERS

#### A. REPORT OF COMMITTEE TO APPROVE BUILDING SCHEMATIC PLANS AND COST ESTIMATES

The following is the report of the Board Committee which approved schematic plans and cost estimates of the Health Professions Building.

The Committee to approve the Health Professions Building schematic plans and cost estimates met February 4, 1992, via teleconference. In attendance were Trustees Bruce Baker (Chairman), Charles Combs, and Robert Swan. Also attending were President David L. Rice, Donald Bennett, Richard Schmidt, and Byron Wright.

After discussion of the various revisions made by the architects, a motion was made by Mr. Combs to approve the schematic plans and cost estimates (cost estimates in Exhibit II-A). Mr. Swan seconded the motion and it passed by a unanimous vote.

# B. APPROVAL TO ESTABLISH FIFTH THIRD BANK OF CENTRAL INDIANA AS A BANK DEPOSITORY

On a motion by Mr. McKenna, sconded by Mrs. Torain, the following resolution was approved.

- BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fifth Third Bank of Central Indiana, be and hereby is designated a depository in which the funds of this Corporation may be deposited by its officers, agents, and employees.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of this Corporation is authorized to sign (including use of facsimile signatures) any and all checks, drafts and orders, including orders or directions in informal or letter form, against any funds at any time standing to the credit of this Corporation with the said Bank, and/or against any account of this Corporation with the said bank, and that the said Bank hereby is authorized to honor any and all checks, drafts, and orders so signed, including those drawn to the individual order of such officer without further inquiry or regard to the authority of said officer or the use of said checks, drafts, and orders, or the proceeds thereof.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of the Board of Trustees of the University of Southern Indiana is authorized to enter into a Funds Transfer Agreement with The Fifth Third Bank of Central Indiana.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of the Board of Trustees of the University of Southern Indiana, the Assistant Vice President for Business Affairs, and the Controller of the University of Southern Indiana be designated as the officers of the University authorized to make wire transfers.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each of the foregoing resolutions shall continue in force until express written notice of its rescission or modification has been received by the said Bank, but if the authority contained in them should be revoked or terminated by operation of law without such notice, it is resolved and hereby agreed for the purpose of inducing the said Bank to act thereunder, that the said Bank shall be saved harmless from any loss suffered or liability incurred by it in so acting after revocation or termination without such notice.

#### C. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER TO SELL, ASSIGN, AND CAUSE TO BE TRANSFERRED STOCKS, BONDS, RIGHTS, OPTIONS AND SECURITIES OF ANY DESCRIPTION STANDING IN THE NAME OF OR BELONGING TO THIS CORPORATION IN ANY CAPACITY

On a motion by Mr. Combs, seconded by Mr. McKenna, the following resolution was approved.

- BE IT RESOLVED, that the Treasurer is authorized and empowered to sell, assign, and cause to be transferred stocks, bonds, rights, options, and securities of any description standing in the name of or belonging to this corporation in any capacity and the said officer is authorized and empowered to execute any and all papers that may be necessary in order to effect the sale of such securities and transfer thereof to the purchasers.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said officer of this corporation be and hereby is authorized and empowered to cause to be registered in his name or in the names of any of them, or in the name of any broker or nominee, securities owned by the corporation.

### D. APPROVAL OF BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS, ADJUSTMENTS, AND TRANSFERS

On a motion by Mr. Swan, seconded by Mrs. Torain, the following Budget Appropriations, Adjustments, and Transfers were approved.

#### E. APPROVAL OF BUILDING DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Representatives of Odle McGuire & Shook, architects, presented the design development plan for the Health Professions Building. Discussion followed on details of the design development plan. On a motion by Mrs. Torain, seconded by Mr. McKenna, the design development plan was approved.

#### F. APPROVAL OF DECLARATION OF OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES

- WHEREAS, the University of Southern Indiana (the "Corporation") intends to acquire, construct or rehabilitate, and equip a Health Professions Building on the University campus at Evansville, including related site preparation for the building and expansion to the central campus boiler and chiller plant (the "Project"); and
- WHEREAS, the Corporation reasonably expects to reimburse certain costs of the Project with proceeds of debt which has been issued and by additional debt to be incurred by the Corporation; and
- WHEREAS, the Corporation has issued debt in the amount of \$9,000,000 toward the project construction costs and expects to issue additional debt of \$5,540,000, plus the costs of debt issuance, for the purpose of reimbursing costs of the Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Corporation intends that this Declaration of Official Intent to Reimburse expenditures constitutes a declaration of official intent pursuant to Treas. Reg. S1.103-18 (1992);
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Corporation declares its official intent pursuant to Treas. Reg. S1.103-18 (1992) to acquire, construct or rehabilitate, and equip the Project; to reimburse certain costs of acquiring, constructing or rehabilitating, and equipping the Project with proceeds of the \$9,000,000 in debt issued by the Corporation; and to issue additional debt of \$5,540,000 plus the costs of debt issuance, for the purpose of reimbursing costs of the Project.

On a motion by Mr. Swan, seconded by Mr. Huber, the preceding resolution was approved.

## SECTION III - PERSONNEL MATTERS

#### A. APPROVAL OF AUTHORIZATION FOR EMPLOYMENT OF FACULTY AND STAFF

Pursuant to Indiana Code 20-12-1-4 the University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees annually authorizes the President of the University of Southern Indiana to employ faculty and staff, and to establish salaries and wages within budgetary capabilities.

On a motion by Mrs. Torain, seconded by Mr. Swan, the Board of Trustees <u>authorized</u> the President of the University of Southern Indiana to employ qualified faculty and staff, to grant leaves of absence, and to establish salaries, wages, and benefits for employees within the capabilities of the budget. Further, the Board, which establishes the employment contract for the President of the University, including salary and benefits, <u>authorized</u> the chairman of the Board to convey to the President his employment contract, including salary and benefits.

#### **B. APPROVAL OF PERSONNEL ACTIONS**

On a motion by Mr. Swan, seconded by Mr. Huber, the following personnel actions were approved as amended.

<u>Tenure</u> The following faculty members are recommended for continuous appointment, effective August 23, 1993.

Ronald C. Roat, Assistant Professor of Journalism, School of Liberal Arts.

Marwan A. Wafa, Assistant Professor of Business, School of Business.
