The Long-Range Planning Committee of the University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees met on Saturday, May 4, 2002, in the University Center Room 206. 1. REPORT ON UNIVERSITY OUTREACH INITIATIVES

Mr. Baker called on Dr. Reid to introduce the discussion topics. Dr. Reid called the committee members' attention to two academic programs previously reviewed by the committee which are on the board agenda for approval in today's meeting -- the Master of Public Administration (MPA) degree program and the revised Bachelor of Science in Engineering (BSE) degree program.

Dr. Reid called on Dr. Jones, who gave an overview of the University's outreach programs which address not only continuing education, but also workforce and economic development in the region.

Presentations on individual initiatives were given by Dr. Wilhelmus (School of Liberal Arts Outreach Programs), Mr. Bohleber (Development for the Regional Hispanic Workforce), and Ms. McDowell (Long-Term Corporate Training Partnerships). A presentation by Dr. Partridge and Dr. Kovanic (Web-Based Team Training Module) was postponed to a future date in the interest of time.
