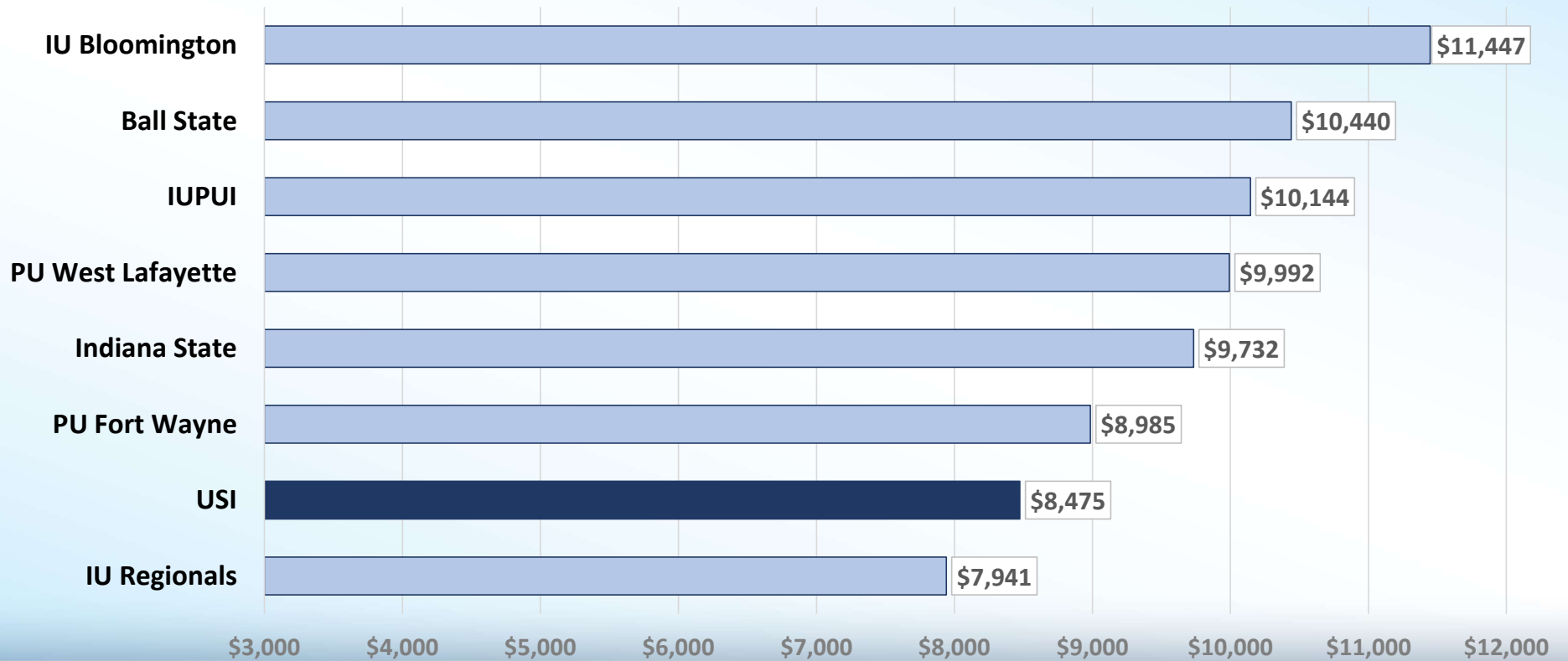
## Purpose of Tuition Hearing

- To present the USI administration's recommended tuition and fees for 2023-2025 academic terms
- USI Board of Trustees has statutory authority and responsibility under Indiana Code to establish tuition and fees on a bi-annual basis
- Students, parents, and members of the public are invited to make public comment

# Tuition and Fee Hearing Requirements

- Governor Holcomb signed HB 1001 on May 4, 2023
- Indiana Commission for Higher Education voted to approve recommended tuition targets on May 18, 2023
- State Educational Institutions are required to hold public tuition hearings within 30 days of the Commission setting recommended targets
- University of Southern Indiana is required to set two-year tuition and fees at today's hearing

# Current Tuition and Fees Comparison



## 2023-2025 Funding Priorities

- Support purposeful and sustainable growth in enrollment, retention, and lifelong learning
- Ensure that students have access to relevant experiential learning activities and obtain employer desired professional skills
- Support opportunities that enhance faculty skills and capabilities related to teaching, research, and service activities
