1. REPORT ON THE POTT SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING

Dean Jerome Cain presented an overview of the school's history and a report on its recent priorities, strategies, and results. He discussed facilities enhancement, the acquisition of scientific equipment, faculty development, and faculty/student research support. He reported that USI faculty and students now have outstanding physical facilities in which to learn, teach, and work, and noted the significant support of University friends and donors, which made possible many enhancements to the Science and Education Center.
