# **Applicant Funnel**

USI's selectivity increased as the percentage of applicants accepted dropped from 88% in 2009 to 74% in 2010. This decrease in acceptance rate was due in part to the 2,262 additional applications received during College Go! Week in 2010.

## **Undergraduate Characteristics**


USI's student body has lower percentages of minorities and undergraduate residents. In contrast, it has higher percentages of women and part-time students.

## Freshmen Retention


USI has increased freshmen retention over the past 10 years. USI's Fall 2009 cohort had the highest ever one-year retention rate at 69%.
