

Incoming Student Enrollment

Compared to 10 years ago, the total number of incoming graduate students has increased to 273, compared to 258 in fall 2003. The number of incoming freshmen has dropped, with 2,079 in fall 2003 and 1,876 in fall 2012.


- 9.8% decrease in incoming freshmen students
- 2.5% decrease in incoming transfer students
- 5.8% increase in incoming graduate students

Freshman Retention

The 1-year retention rate of the fall 2011 freshman cohort increased to 67% from of 65% in 2010.



Undergraduate Student Enrollment


Over the past 10 years, overall undergraduate enrollment has increased by more than 3%, from 9,154 in fall 2003 to 9,498 in fall 2012.



Graduation Rates

Compared with the fall 2000 cohort, the fall 2008 4-year graduation rate has risen by 2.9 percentage points. The cumulative 6-year rate has risen from 32.9% for the fall 2000 cohort to 35.5% for the fall 2006 cohort.



<u>Degrees Awarded – Academic Year 2002-03 to 2011-12</u> Since 2002-03, the number of USI degrees awarded annually has increased 33%, up from 1,386 in 2002-03 to 1,841 in 2011-12.
