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Undergraduate Characteristics


USI's student body continues to have lower percentages of minorities and undergraduate residents compared to other state universities. In addition, USI continues to have higher percentages of women and part-time students.

These data highlight the importance of USI's Strategic Plan goal to increase the graduation rate.




Six Year Graduation Rate Four year Graduation Rate

Freshmen Retention


The Fall 2012 retention rate of 67% is higher than the Fall 2011 rate of 65%.

Current State Appropriation and Tuition Funding

In 2013-2014, USI continues to receive the least amount of state funding while charging the lowest tuition on a per-FTE student basis.
