



PREDICTED ACADEMIC DIFFICULTY- PAD

OVERALL RISK INDEX- ORI

#### **Passive**

Emails and texts both before and after classes started



#### **Active**

Grouped with Overall Risk Index and Predicted Academic Difficulties

Intentional interventions

Experimented with a control group




### Results - Made Appointments to review CSI

- Overall population- 70 students
  - Experimental group- 56
  - Control- 14
  - 38 of the 56 68% actively participated



## Results - Registration Advising Appointments

Experimental Group- 49/56 Control- 11/14





## Results - Registered for Spring 2023





## Targets

- Increase first time/ full time first year student retention
- Decrease first year students on academic probation
