Pre-Med, Pre-Osteopathy, Pre-Podiatry

There is no specific major to prepare for medical school. Admission requirements for medical school vary for different schools. Students must take the MCAT, which covers information from the required courses. The following are required courses for the application to medical school: BIOL 141, BIOL 334, BIOL 434, CHEM 261, CHEM 262, CHEM 353, CHEM 354, PHYS 175 and PHYS 176 (or PHYS 205 and PHYS 206), PSY 201, SOC 121, MATH 230 (or STAT 241). The following courses are a typical course of study for a biology major interested in admission to medical, osteopathic, or podiatric training:
