
Title: New Harmony Heritage Days Bingo	Date(s):
IN Academic Standards: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3.3.1 Use labels and symbols to locate and identify physical and political features on maps and/or globes	
Materials/Resources: New Harmony town map (attached); Blank Bingo Card (attached); marker; Bingo chips (something to mark off squares)	
Objectives/Learning Targets: Students will learn to follow directions using a compass rose and the map provided. This will also prepare them for the field trip to Heritage Artisan Days by familiarizing themselves with a map of New Harmony. This activity can also be extended to Heritage Artisan Days by providing the students with a compass and a town map (attached) and instructing students to trace the route they walk that day on the map. Instructors can also stop at various points throughout the day and instruct students to locate where they are on the map and tell which direction is north.	
Assessment: Students will end the day with a Bingo card and can be evaluated for participation and comprehension.	
Introduction/Motivation/Springboard: As motivation for this activity, the instructor should explain the importance of being able to read various types and styles of maps by providing examples of when map-reading skills can be used in a practical setting. Mention that their new understanding of maps can be put to use in a practical setting on the field trip to Heritage Days.	
Procedures/Activities/Tasks/Examples: Students should each be provided with a Blank Bingo card (attached). Using the map of New Harmony (attached), instruct students to fill in each Bingo square with a letter/number of a location on the map (to increase the difficulty, location names can be used instead of letters/numbers). Use each letter/number only once. Once the students have filled in their Bingo cards the instructor can then give directions to various locations across town. The students will utilize map-interpreting skills to see if they have that location on their Bingo card. <u>Examples:</u> The letter at the intersection of Church Street and East Street. The number located across the street, directly south of letter "I"	

Closure Activity/Extensions/Homework: An extension of this activity is to provide compasses along with a map that is provided when schools arrive at Heritage Artisan Days in New Harmony. Students can draw the route they take throughout the day. At various points throughout the day, students may be instructed to find their location and orientation on the map using their compass and surroundings.
