Eligibility:

- Be at least 60 years old (attach copy of Indiana driver's license or State ID)
- Must be admissible to the University
- Be retired or were employed on a full-time basis and are no longer employed, or full-time homemaker and never employed outside the home
- May enroll full-time or part-time
- In a undergraduate program, given that space is available in the course
- Must be an Indiana resident
- You must submit a new application for each term you want to use this tuition exemption.

There is no limit to the number of terms for which a student may receive the Senior Citizen Tuition Exemption. The exemption is equal to 50% of tuition. Students are eligible to use up to a maximum of 9 credit hours per semester. **Special fees, study abroad courses, non-credit courses (including workshops), and partnership programs are not eligible for the tuition exemption.** The addition of the tuition exemption may change an existing Financial Aid offer.

The Senior Citizen Tuition Exemption is not retroactive for previous terms prior to submission of the application.
