Outstanding Teaching by an Adjunct Faculty Member

Nomination guidelines: No self-nominations or anonymous nominations are accepted. Nominations may be submitted by any faculty member, alumnus, administrator, or student *not currently enrolled in the nominated faculty member's class(es)*. The nominee must have taught at USI for a minimum of three consecutive semesters, or one semester for three consecutive years, and be a current member of the USI faculty (teaching during the 2018-2019 year).

Nominations are limited to one page. Do not attach additional pages. Nominations are due on February 28. Send or bring this form to the Provost's Office, Wright Administration, Room 103, 8600 University Blvd., Evansville, IN 47712. The award winner will receive a \$2,000 cash stipend. No faculty member may receive this award more than once.
