Bingo Review Activity

Purpose: To create an enjoyable format that will help students review and reinforce their knowledge of Indiana Civil War information.

Material needed:

- 1. One bingo history play sheet for each student.
- 2. Twenty four review questions of the short answer variety.
- 3. Tokens if desired, although different markings and symbols can be used.
- 4. Appropriate prizes if desired.

Organization and preperation:

- 1. The teacher should either prepare a variety of forms of the play sheets or instruct the students to randomly complete the blank play sheets.
- The students may participate by individually submitting review questions that pertain to the material to be studied.
- 3. Instruct students to write small enough so that only part of each space is used for each answer. In this way several games could be played on the same play sheet.
- 4. The teacher should read the questions or clues and the students should mark their answers. When a student believes he/she has a bingo the student should check the play sheet for the correct answers.
- 5. If the answers are not correct the current game continues. If the answers are correct, begin a new game. Proceed until all questions have been used at least twice.
