The USI Biology degree allows a high degree of flexibility for students to pursue their particular areas of interest. The following are required courses for the USI Biology Degree: BIOL 141, BIOL 151, BIOL 152, BIOL 215, BIOL 333, BIOL 334, BIOL 382, BIOL 481, CHEM 261, CHEM 262, CHEM 353, CHEM 354, PHYS 175 and PHYS 176 (or PHYS 205 and PHYS 206), and 18 hours of BIOL Electives.
