# LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR ROBERT D. ORR TO GIVE COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

The Honorable Robert D. Orr, Lieutenant Governor of Indiana, will give the 1973 commencement address.

Elected to the post of Lieutenant Governor by one of the largest margins in the state's history, Robert Orr presides over the Indiana Senate, is director of the Department of Commerce and serves as commissioner of agriculture.

The Lieutenant Governor has been extremely active in Republican politics for more than twenty years. He served as precinct committeeman from 1954 to 1962 and rebuilt the Vanderburgh County Republican organization, serving as its chairman from 1965-1971. He has been a delegate to nearly every Republican state convention since 1952 and served as an alternate delegate to the 1956 Republican National Convention. Robert Orr was treasurer of the 8th District Republican Central Committee from 1956-1958.

In addition to his political activities, Robert Orr is secretary-treasurer of Sign Crafters, Inc., former chairman of Indian Industries, Inc., and has served as director of several other firms.

The Evansville native is also active in civic affairs as vice-president of the Boy Scout Council, past vice-president of Evansville's Future, Inc., a community progress group; and former director of the Indiana Manufacturers Association. He is a trustee of Hanover College and the Willard Library.

Mr. Orr enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1942 and rose from the rank of private to major in the Quartermaster Corps. He was discharged in 1946, after service in the Aleutian Islands, New Guinea, the Philippines, Okinawa and Japan. He was awarded the Legion of Merit.

The Lieutenant Governor is an alumnus of Yale University and the Harvard Business School.

He is married to the former Joanne (Josie) Wallace, who has actively encouraged cultural enrichments of the state by serving as a member of the Indiana Arts Commission. They have three children: Robert D. Orr, Jr. and twin daughters, Mrs. Susan O. Dunn and Robbin Orr.

The degree of Doctor of Civil Law will be conferred upon Robert D. Orr who has compiled a distinguished record of service in government, civic life and business.

# Conferring of Honorary Degrees



#### WALTER JOSEPH WAHNSIEDLER

A noted Evansville educator, Walter J. Wahnsiedler will receive the degree of Doctor of Humanities. Mr. Wahnsiedler began his distinguished educational career as a teacher of history, botany, and physics at Mt. Vernon High School. After advanced graduate studies work, Mr. Wahnsiedler taught at University of Tulsa and the State University of Tennessee. He returned to Evansville in 1937 to teach history and psychology at Central High School, where he was head of the History department for twelve of the twenty-three years he taught at Central High School. An original faculty member when the Evansville Campus of Indiana State University opened in 1965, Mr. Wahnsiedler helped make public higher education in Evansville become a reality.

As an historian, Mr. Wahnsiedler is keenly aware of the need to preserve data and artifacts for future generations. As a civic leader he has been one of the leading supporters of the Conrad Baker Foundation, both as donor and volunteer. He serves as vice-president of the Evansville Astronomical Society and for the past eight years has been organist at Bethany Christian Church.



#### ROBERT LOUIS KOCH

The degree of Doctor of Civil Law will be conferred upon Robert L. Koch, industrialist and civic leader. An astute businessman, Mr. Koch is president of George Koch Sons, Inc., and Director of several business enterprises including Suntone Products, Inc., Commercial Office Services, Inc., Santa Claus Land, Inc., R. Malcolm and Associates, and Gibbs Die Casting Aluminum.

An Evansville native, his community has benefited by Mr. Koch's involvement in Downtown Kiwanis, Executive Committee of United Fund, Junior Achievement of Evansville, Boys Club of Evansville, Deaconess Hospital Foundation, Indiana State University Evansville Advisory Board, Indiana Region 13 Health Planning Council and numerous other civic programs.

A friend of higher education, Mr. Koch's inspired leadership was the key ingredient in the establishment of Southern Indiana Higher Education, Inc., an organization which created the Mid-America University Center consisting of more than 1400 acres of land for higher education. Indiana State University Evansville is presently situated on 300 acres of that tract. Mr. Koch is current President and Director of Southern Indiana Higher Education, Inc.



#### HELEN ELLIOTT

Miss Helen Elliott, New Harmony, Indiana, will receive a Doctor of Humanities degree. An educator, philanthropist, and community leader, Miss Elliott taught English and history and became principal at Poseyville High School prior to teaching history and serving as Senior Guidance Counselor at Technical High School in Indianapolis for twenty-seven years.

With her family roots four generations deep in her native New Harmony, dating to the Robert Owen community, Miss Elliott is most conscious of the historical significance of New Harmony. She was secretary of the state of New Harmony Memorial Commission, a consultant for the documentary film on New Harmony prepared by Indiana University, a benefactor to the Robert Owen Bicentennial Conference, and is currently a member of the Board of Directors of Harmonie Associates and of the Posey County National Bank.

In 1965 Miss Elliott, with her sister Mrs. Ruth Elliott Hickam, gave a farm south of New Harmony to form the nucleus of Harmonie State Park. The gift was given in memory of their father.
