

CARNEGIE PRESIDENT EMERITUS DAVID A. HAMBURG WILL BRING COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS



David A. Hamburg

Dr. David A. Hamburg, president emeritus of the Carnegie Corporation of New York and a native of Evansville, will bring the address in tonight's Commencement Exercises. In recognition of his prominence in research, medicine, education, and societal issues, the University will confer an honorary Doctor of Laws degree on Dr. Hamburg.

Dr. Hamburg served as the Carnegie Corporation's eleventh president from 1982 to 1997. Under his leadership the work of the Corporation focused on education and health development of children and youth, human resources in developing countries, and international security issues. He established a number of task forces on education and preventing conflict, which produced seminal research and policy analysis and which will continue to influence the work in these fields in the future.

A psychiatrist who earned both his A.B. and M.D. degrees at Indiana University, Dr. Hamburg has been concerned with the problems of human aggression and violence, especially with violence prevention and conflict resolution. He directed the adult psychiatry branch of the National Institutes of Health from 1958 to 1961 and served as professor and chair of the department of psychiatry and behavioral sciences at Stanford University for the next eleven years. Beginning in 1975

he was president of the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences, and later was named the director of the division of health policy research and education and the John D. MacArthur Professor of Health Policy at Harvard University. He served as president and then chairman of the board of the American Association for the Advancement of Sciences.

Dr. Hamburg is a member of President Clinton's Committee of Advisors on Science and Technology and a visiting professor at Harvard Medical School's department of social medicine. The author of *Today's Children: Creating a Future for a Generation in Crisis*, (1992), Dr. Hamburg has concentrated on child and adolescent development in recent years.

He was a member of the United States Defense Policy Board with Secretary of Defense William Perry and co-chair with former Secretary of State Cyrus Vance of the Carnegie Commission on Preventing Deadly Conflict. He was the founder of the Carnegie Commission on Science, Technology, and Government.

Dr. Hamburg received the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian honor, in 1996. He also is the recipient of the American Psychiatric Association's Distinguished Service Award, the International Peace Academy's 25th Anniversary Special Award, the Achievement in Children and Public Policy Award from the Society for Research in Child Development, and the National Academy of Sciences' Public Welfare Medal.

BETTY F. RICE AND IRA T. NEAL TO BE RECOGNIZED

Honorary doctorates will be conferred on Betty Fordice Rice and Ira Tinsley Neal in recognition of their accomplishments to education and society.

Betty Fordice Rice was USI's founding first lady and an able partner to Dr. David L. Rice, the first president of the University. For 27 years, Mrs. Rice assisted in building the University and focused special interest in building community support for USI. Armed with vision and boundless energy, Mrs. Rice served as official University hostess and special events planner, providing warm hospitality to thousands of students, faculty, staff, alumni, and friends of the University each year. She also helped to establish student life programs on the campus, including Greek-letter organizations, Madrigal dinners, and other cultural events.

For the first 15 years, the Rices opened their personal home to the University family and guests. In 1983, the USI Foundation built and donated the University Home as the official residence for the first family. Mrs. Rice was instrumental in the planning, design, and decorating of the home.


For more than three decades, Mrs. Rice has served dozens of community organizations, including the boards of directors of the Raintree Council Girl Scouts, American Association of University Women, United Way of Southwestern Indiana, YWCA, Evansville Home Economists, Extension Homemakers, Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra, Operation City Beautiful, and Westwood Garden Club. She has held leadership positions with many of these.

An avid gardener, Mrs. Rice was owner of Peckenpaugh's Garden Center in Evansville for several years. When the Rices retired from USI, they moved to nearby New Harmony, Indiana, where they continue to be active community leaders. Mrs. Rice is a member of the executive committee of the USI-New Harmony Foundation Board of Directors and the Posey County Community Foundation Board of Directors. She continues to volunteer daily at the Girl Scout office in Evansville. Mrs. Rice was honorary co-chair of the Faculty/Staff division of *Campaign USI*, the University's first capital campaign, and she frequently opens her New Harmony home for University events.

Mrs. Rice earned bachelor's and master's degrees from Purdue University. In 1981 she received the Purdue University "Service to Others Award," the highest award given to an outstanding graduate. She will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in tonight's ceremony.

A Doctor of Laws degree will also be conferred on Dr. Neal in recognition of his achievements in education and his public service to the African American community both locally and in the Midwest.

Dr. Neal attended school in Memphis, Tennessee, and earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Evansville, a master's degree from Indiana University, and a doctorate in education from Nova Southeastern University in Florida.

In his career as an educator, he has worked with the Evansville-Vanderburgh School Corporation as teacher, director of federally-funded projects, and coordinator of cultural diversity activities. His responsibilities have extended to human relations, race relations, conflict resolution, affirmative action programs, staff development, and the recruitment of minority personnel for the school corporation. He also has been a trustee of Vincennes University and a member of the advisory committee for the Indiana University School of Medicine, Evansville Center. Since 1973, he has been an adjunct professor at USI.

Early in his career, Dr. Neal was executive director of the Community Action Program of Evansville and director of the Head Start program. In these positions, he directed programs which provided developmental services for low-income preschool children and social services for their families. He currently coordinates the African American Academy, a Saturday morning enrichment program; Project S.E.T (Students Exploring Teaching); and the Math Peer Tutoring program.

Dr. Neal has been a member of the Police Merit Commission and the Vanderburgh County Judicial Nominating Commission and was a founding member of the Community Foundation Alliance. His work has earned him the NAACP Education Committee Service Award, the Black Leadership Conference Civil Rights Award, the Mayor's Human Relations Award, and the Kappa Alpha Psi Humanitarian Award. Dr. Neal is an active member of New Hope Baptist Church where he teaches Sunday School and is a deacon and trustee.

JOHN GOTTCENT AND JILL WELDEN WILL RECEIVE UNIVERSITY'S HIGHEST HONORS

The University's highest honors will be awarded during tonight's ceremony to Dr. John H. Gottcent, professor of English and University Core coordinator, and to Jill Marie Welden, a senior from Morganfield, Kentucky.

Dr. Gottcent was chosen by his colleagues to receive the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor Award. The award is made possible by a generous gift from Integra Bank, formerly known as National City Bank of Evansville.

Dr. Gottcent holds the Doctor of Philosophy degree from the University of Wisconsin, the Master of Arts from the State University of New York at Binghamton, and the Bachelor of Arts degree from Harpur College. He joined the faculty of USI in 1970 as assistant professor, was promoted to associate professor in 1975, and to professor in 1982. He served as chair of the English Department from 1977 to 1981. For more than a decade, Dr. Gottcent has been the coordinator of the University Core Curriculum (UCC), a portion of academic work required of all degree-seeking students.

As coordinator, Dr. Gottcent meets with new and prospective students and families to introduce the program and foster understanding of its importance in encouraging students to achieve personal growth and contribute meaningfully to society.

He also organizes faculty retreats and publishes booklets describing the UCC. University colleagues have praised his vision in guiding the development, implementation, and constant improvement of the UCC. They also cite his ability as a teacher.

One of Dr. Gottcent's nominators said that what distinguishes him from most faculty members is that he sees himself primarily as an *educator* - who happens to teach in the English Department.

Dr. Gottcent is a member of the Association for General and Liberal Studies and serves on the executive council of its national board. He also has served a two-year term as the state faculty representative on the Indiana Commission for Higher Education, a gubernatorial appointment. After his term ended, he served as a member of the Commission's Task Force on Retention. He has been active on many University committees and has given leadership to faculty governance through the Faculty Senate.

A writer and biblical studies scholar, Dr. Gottcent's work has been published in numerous professional journals. He also has written books on the Bible in literature and on critical thinking.

The Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty Senate selected Jill M. Welden as this year's recipient of the President's Medal. She was chosen because of her commitment to academic excellence and her service to the University and the community. She will graduate *summa cum laude* with a Bachelor of Science degree with an accounting major and an economics minor. One of her professors said of her, "Jill raised the level of any class she was in by challenging the remaining students by her own academic performance. She is certainly the premier accounting graduate at USI this year."

Ms. Welden has served as an Amigo Orientation Leader and has held leadership roles in several clubs. She is a charter member and former officer in the Speaking Eagles, a student Toastmaster's Club. She also has been an officer in the Accounting Club.

As a senior, Ms. Welden worked as a faculty assistant, teaching help sessions in upper-level accounting classes. She has held a finance co-op position with GE Plastics in the Commercial Finance department. While in that position, she served on the Co-op Council and volunteered as its placement chair. Her manager at GE said, "Jill has become the natural leader of our on-site finance co-op staff of nine. They rely on her for training and guidance because of her broad skill set and her honest desire to help them succeed."

Ms. Welden plans to attend USI summer sessions and enroll next fall in USI's Master of Accountancy program. She ultimately plans to sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) examination and to practice public accounting as a career.

Ms. Welden is the daughter of Gary and Cathy Welden of Morganfield, Kentucky.

Other finalists for the President's Medal were Mary Jo Hagedorn, Danielle Hargis, Chris Webb, and Elizabeth Verkamp.

Presidential Medallion

During the Middle Ages, medallions signified membership in religious orders and guilds and, in the Renaissance, membership in elite orders of knighthood and prominence in government office. Today, colleges and universities strike medallions to commemorate important events and achievements. The University of Southern Indiana Presidential Medallion signifies the authority invested in the president.

Fabricated in bronze, the Presidential Medallion celebrates the 1995 inauguration of President H. Ray Hoops. At its center the bronze medallion bears a three-inch reproduction of the University seal, surrounded by a half-inch rim; on the back of the medallion are the names and dates of appointment of the University's presidents. During tonight's ceremony, a replica of the Presidential Medallion will be presented to Jill M. Welden. This is the highest honor given to a graduating senior.

University Seal

The University seal bears the University's colors—red, white, and blue—with gold. The shield signifies the importance of higher education in defending citizens against ignorance. Between the two banners carrying the University's name appear a band and an open book bound together by the torch of knowledge. In the band, rays of light emanate simultaneously from a rising sun, symbolizing the young University, and from the torch, symbolizing the light of knowledge and the passion for scholarship. Trees on either side of the flame suggest not only the University's pastoral southern Indiana setting but also life, growth, continuity.

Beneath this band, an open book emphasizes the importance of teaching and learning; *academia populi* and *academia populo* indicate that the University of Southern

Indiana is a scholarly academy founded and supported *by the people, for the people*. Finally, the laurel branches to the right and left of the book represent victory: the light of learning overcomes the darkness of ignorance.

University Mace

In the Middle Ages, bodyguards of French and English monarchs carried ceremonial maces. Later, the mace became an important symbol of office in civil processions and academic pageantry; at the University of Southern Indiana, the Grand Marshal, a distinguished member of the faculty, carries the mace.

A replica of the walking cane of Richard Owen (1810-1890) serves as the centerpiece of the University mace. A respected geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University, Owen became the first president of Purdue University. He was a son of Robert Owen (1771-1858), the Welsh industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. The 32-inch-tall, wooden cane was presented to Richard Owen in 1874 and, through the generosity of his descendant Kenneth D. Owen, served as the Grand Marshal's staff until the mace was fabricated for the University's first Presidential Inauguration in 1995.

Designed and fabricated by Nicholas Logsdon of Indianapolis, the University mace encloses a replica of the Owen cane and is gold-plated. At the top, above the cane's golden head, an open orb holds a replica of the University seal. The free-flowing design of the orb symbolizes the interrelationships among all academic disciplines. Below the cane's tip are three golden rings engraved with the names and appointment dates of the University presidents. A finial at the tip of the cane bears the names of Kenneth Dale Owen, Jane Blaffer Owen,

and James A. Sanders, donors of the mace.

Designed and created by alumnus Kenny Fisher '77, the replica of the cane and the base are made of walnut from the Owen mansion built in New Harmony during the 1830s.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in tonight's ceremony are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift of the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.

Photography During Ceremony

A commercial photographer is taking photographs of each graduate as he/she shakes hands with the President. Each graduate will receive a proof from which duplicates can be ordered. Family members who wish to take still or video photographs during the ceremony are asked to use the restricted area on the floor. Security guards will ask those who block aisles in the stands or occupy the area behind the stage to move. Your cooperation ensures the dignity of the Commencement ceremony.

Commemorative Video

In response to requests from graduates and families, a high-quality commemorative videotape of today's ceremony is being produced by the USI Office of Instructional Technology Services in cooperation with the USI Alumni Association.
