J. R. "Dick" Harris Memorial Scholarship

Geology majors are invited to apply for the J. R. "Dick" Harris Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship was made possible by a donation from the Southwest Indiana Higher Education Commission. Dick Harris was well-known professional geologist in southwestern Indiana who served in the state legislature and was instrumental in bringing about the state's geologist licensing law.

This award will be made to a geology major who has completed at least 15 hours of courses required for the geology major (this may include elective geology courses taken to satisfy major requirements), a cumulative GPA of greater than 3.00, and who intends to apply his/her geological knowledge to environmental issues, or work in the petroleum industry or other geologically-oriented business.

The award varies each year according to performance of the endowed fund, but this year can be expected to be in the range of about \$1,000 to \$1,200.

Apply by submitting an application outlining the geology courses you have completed, academic accomplishments, student leadership, extra-curricular activities, and future academic plans and career goals.
