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Anonymous Kits

- Anonymous Kit vs Non-reporting Kit
 - What makes this process different?
- Establish a clear process within your facility and the local Sexual Assault Response Team (SART)
- Do NOT put identifying information on forms, documents, or the kit that is to be shared with external partners
 - Including the Indiana Sexual Assault Kit (SAK) Tracking System
- Minors (17 years and younger) cannot be anonymous or non-reporting**



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Drug Facilitated Sexual Assault (DFSA)

- Assess all patients for DFSA
- What to do when you and/or your patient suspect DFSA
 - Collect the sample
 - Urine collection is the gold standard
- Submit to contracted forensic toxicology lab (third party) or law enforcement agency
 - Develop a process within your facility and SART
- Commonly used third party forensic toxicology laboratories*
 - AIT
 - NIMS
 - Axis
