Anonymous Kits

- Anonymous Kit vs Non-reporting Kit · What makes this process different?
- Establish a clear process within your facility and the local Sexual Assault Response T_{AR1}n (SART)
- Do NOT put identifying information on forms,
- documents, or the kit that is to be shared with external partners Including the Indiana Sexual Assault Kit (SAK) Tracking System
- Minors (17 years and younger) cannot be anonymous or non-reporting

Drug Facilitated Sexual Assault (DFSA) Assess all patients for DFSA • What to do when you and/or your patient suspect DFSA Collect the sample • Urine collection is the gold standard • Submit to contracted forensic toxicology lab (third party) or law enforcement agency Develop a process within your facility and SART Commonly used third party forensic toxicology laboratories* • AIT • NIMS • Axis *DO NOT CONTACT THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF TOXICOLOGY FOR DFSA TESTING Health
