The following courses are required for admission to the **Purdue University College of Pharmacy**: **Biol 141, Biol 333, Biol 375/376, Biol 121/122, Biol 422, Biol 434, Chem 261/262, Chem 353/354, Phys 175, Math 230/235, Stat 241, Cmst 101, Eng 101, Economics.** Requirements vary by university and many schools, including Purdue, do not require completion of a baccalaureate degree (BS or BA). You should confirm the requirements of each program in which you are interested. The following courses are a typical course of study for a biology major interested in Pharmacy school:
