FIVE WILL BE HONORED FOR ACHIEVEMENTS

In tonight's ceremony, the University will confer honorary doctoral degrees on five individuals who have made significant contributions to the business, cultural, and educational environment in southern Indiana. Honored will be Margaret Henderson Blair, Jennings D. and Josephine K. Carter, Byron C. Wright, and Gordon L. St. Angelo. Mr. St. Angelo will bring the Commencement Address.

A native of southern Indiana, Mr. St. Angelo has been program director of the Lilly Endowment in Indianapolis since 1974. Mr. St. Angelo grew up in Huntingburg and graduated in 1950 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics and business

administration from North Central College in Naperville, Illinois. He worked with First National Bank of Chicago and Merchants Motor Freight System, Inc. before moving back to Huntingburg to become president of St. Angelo's, Inc., a family-owned clothing business. Mr. St. Angelo became active in Democrat Party work and led John F. Kennedy's campaign in Indiana in 1960. He was chairman of Roger D. Branigin's successful campaign for Governor of Indiana in 1964, and subsequently became

chairman of the Indiana Democratic State Central Committee, serving from 1964-74. Mr. St. Angelo also was national co-chair of the Humphrey for President Committee, deputy chairman of the Democrat National Committee for two years, and a five-time delegate to the national convention, where he served as delegation chair twice.

At the Lilly Endowment, Mr. St. Angelo's range of responsibilities includes community development, public policy, free market economic development in North and South America, and other public policy interests. Through his work with the Endowment, he has worked closely in the preservation and promotion of the historic community of New Harmony. He serves as vice chairman of the Blaffer Trust and also of the State Commission on New Harmony. Mr. St. Angelo's leadership is sought in Indianapolis civic affairs, where he is vice president of the Indianapolis Airport Authority, a trustee of the Indianapolis Foreign Trade Zone, and serves on the executive committee of both the Indianapolis Economic Club and the University of Indianapolis, from which he received an honorary doctorate in 1974. He also is an elder of Second Presbyterian Church and a member of the Mexican Institute for Public Service, the Mont Pelerin Society, the International Airport Council, and the Civil War Roundtable. He is chairman of the *Indianapolis Star* Jefferson Awards which recognize voluntary community service.

Mr. St. Angelo received the Castaldi Award from the United Way of Indiana, the Man of the Year Award from the Junior Chamber of Commerce, and the Citizen of the Year Award from the Fraser Institute of Canada. He recently received the Spirit of Philanthropy award from the Indiana University Center for Philanthropy. He will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree.

Margaret Henderson Blair will receive a Doctor of Science degree in recognition of her pioneering research methods. As president of Research Systems Corporation (rsc), Ms. Blair has expanded the company internationally and made rsc a recognized leader in advertising research.

Ms. Blair was educated at Sarah Lawrence College in Bronxville, New York, and at the New School for Social Research in New York City. She began her market research career in 1963 in the basic research department of Schwerin Research Corporation.

After Schwerin was acquired by an Indiana firm in 1968, she developed the ARS advertising research methodology between 1968-71 and became executive vice president of the new division. In 1974, with the purchase of the ARS division, Blair co-founded and became president of Research Systems Corporation. The ARS system is the most widely used method for evaluating sales effectiveness of television commercials. Over the years, her company has been responsible for a number of ground-breaking research studies on the development and management of effective

advertising. Many of the findings from these studies have established industry-wide standards. The company now has operations in North America, Latin America, and Europe.

Ms. Blair is chair of Lone Star Studio, a business founded to promote the arts, and in 1992 was USI School of Business Executive in Residence. She is a member of the USI Foundation Advisory Council and was the first individual to underwrite a four-year commitment, which she has renewed, to the Presidential Scholarship program. The program has a goal of keeping Indiana's brightest and best students in the state by providing full scholarships to Indiana valedictorians and salutatorians. Ms. Blair is an active member of First Presbyterian Church. Among her many interests, she excels in saltwater fly and tournament fishing and sailing. She recently won the title of Top Angler in the Don Shula Celebrity Classic Billfish Tournament.

Honorary Doctor of Laws degrees also will be conferred upon Jennings and Josephine Carter in recognition of their creation of a major scholarship endowment at the University of Southern Indiana. The Jennings D. and Josephine K. Carter Scholarships will benefit worthy students who are employed while attending college. To fund the endowment, Mr. and Mrs. Carter established a million dollar charitable remainder unitrust.

The retired Evansville business owners are both natives of Indiana who worked their way through college. Mr. Carter graduated from Indiana University in the early thirties. He began his employment with the Equitable Life Assurance Society in New York City, and later was transferred to a new service office in Indianapolis.

The former Josephine Kizer graduated from high school at age 15 and entered the University of Chicago, where her father had been on the faculty. During her junior year, she had to leave the University because of the Depression. She continued her education with correspondence courses from the University while working in the personal shopping department at the

Marshall Field department store. In 1934, she moved to Indianapolis to manage the personal shopping service at the William H. Block Company. In Indianapolis, she became reacquainted with Mr. Carter, whom she had known when both lived in Mentone, Indiana, and they later were married.

In 1944, the Carters came to Evansville. Mrs. Carter was recruited by the Evansville Courier to manage a new program called "The Women's Forum". Mr. Carter became the manager of Theo. I. Stein Mortgage Company.

At the death of Mr. Stein, the mortgage business was transferred to National City Bank, and Mr. Carter continued as manager of the bank's mortgage loan department. In 1946, Mr. and Mrs. Carter each left their positions to open the Carter Mortgage Service in Evansville. That company expanded to include a general insurance agency and a second mortgage company in Owensboro, Kentucky. In 1960, it was sold to Old National Bank.

In 1970 the Carters moved to Florida, but they have retained their Evansville home as well. While residing in Evansville they were active in many community and volunteer activities. They were members of First Presbyterian Church and the Evansville Country Club. Mr. Carter was a co-founder of the Indiana Chapter of the Mortgage Bankers Association and has been a member of the Society of Residential Appraisers, the Indiana Chapter of the American Institute of Real Estate Appraisers, the Chamber of Commerce, Kiwanis, and the Evansville Zoning Board. Mrs. Carter was a member of the League of Women Voters and volunteered in hospital and church projects. Because of their belief in the merit of enhancing the community in which they worked, and because of their experiences working their way through college, the Carters wanted to extend help to University of Southern Indiana students who work to defray educational expenses.





Byron C. Wright will be honored for shaping the fiscal development of the University of Southern Indiana as the University's vice president for business affairs and treasurer. He now serves as senior vice president, but for 27 years was the chief fiscal officer of the University.

Mr. Wright came to USI in 1967 as the first business manager for the newly-established regional campus of Indiana State University. He was promoted in 1971 to vice president for Business Affairs, and in 1985, when legislative action created the University of Southern Indiana in the place of the regional campus, treasurer of

the University was added to his title. He held those positions until 1993 when he assumed responsibility for coordinating the presidential search to replace Dr. David Rice at retirement.

During Mr. Wright's tenure, he has overseen the development of the University's physical facilities as well as its fiscal policies. He established the first bookstore on the campus, shepherded the development of the USI Foundation, structured the employee base of the University, and gave leadership to USI's outreach activities. Key among those have been the University's management of Historic New Harmony and theatre management in both New Harmony and Lincoln State Park.


Active with community groups, Mr. Wright has assisted with many programs of the Metropolitan Evansville Chamber of Commerce and the YMCA, where he has been chair of the Long-Range Planning Committee and assisted with the capital fund drive. He is a member of the Vanderburgh County Building Authority, the West Side Nut Club, and has been involved in United Way. He frequently is called upon to serve on task forces and study groups on community issues such as taxation and labor relations.

At USI, Mr. Wright has been assistant treasurer of both the USI Foundation and the USI-New Harmony Foundation. In 1991, he was honored with the Special Recognition Award from the USI Alumni Association, which noted his contributions in meeting the educational needs of the people of the southern Indiana region and his extensive efforts in representing those needs to the legislature and governmental officials. His wise advise and counsel earned the respect of university, student, and legislative leaders. He is regarded as the "dean" of university representatives who work with the legislature.

Mr. Wright earned his Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts degrees from Ball State University, where he was finance officer prior to joining USI. He had taught high school business education in Muncie before entering university administration. Mr. Wright will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree.

OUTSTANDING PROFESSOR AND STUDENT WILL BE RECOGNIZED

Dr. Daniel C. Scavone, professor of history, has been selected by his colleagues to receive the National City Bank Distinguished Professor Award. The Distinguished Professor Award is made possible by a generous gift from National City Bank of Evansville. It is composed of a monetary award and a named scholarship award to a deserving USI student. Dr. Scavone's professional activities have demonstrated his commitment to teaching, scholarship, and service. During his 24 years at USI, Dr. Scavone has become a popular instructor, teaching more than 15 different topics in history including graduate seminars in European History.

His special interest in ancient and medieval history has culminated in the publication of three books and over 60 articles, and numerous presentations.

Dr. Scavone joined the USI faculty in 1970 after teaching history at Loyola College in Montreal, Rosary College, Niles College of Loyola University, and Elmhurst College. He earned the Bachelor of Arts, the Master of Arts, and Ph.D. in history from Loyola University in Chicago. He held the Mellon Fellowship at Vanderbilt University in 1983 in Renaissance and Reformation and again for Post-Modern Studies from 1984-86.

Dr. Scavone has served in leadership capacities in many professional and educational organizations. In 1993, he was awarded an Honorary Membership in the Mexican Academy of Sciences. From 1975-77 and again from 1982-84, he was vice-president and president of the Indiana Classical Conference. In the local community, Dr. Scavone served on the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra Board of Directors from 1975-82.

In addition to Dr. Scavone's enthusiasm for history, evidenced in his many hours of service to the University and through his work with students and the community, his interest in world civilizations has taken him abroad many times over the years, including five studies in Italy and four in Greece.

The Student Academic Affairs Committee has selected Travis J Taylor as the 1994 recipient of the President's Medal. The award is the highest honor given to a graduating senior at the University of Southern Indiana. Mr. Taylor was chosen because of his commitment to academic excellence and his service to the University and the community.


Mr. Taylor, a Presidential Scholar from Gas City, Indiana, is graduating *magna cum laude* with a Bachelor of Arts degree in biology. He plans to enter graduate school to prepare for a career as a research scientist and has been accepted to both Vanderbilt University's graduate biomedical program and Harvard University's graduate program in virology. Mr. Taylor's Graduate Record Exam scores have placed him in the 97th percentile nationwide.

As an undergraduate, Mr. Taylor had opportunities to work in science research programs. He participated in the summer undergraduate biomedical research program at Vanderbilt and the

Department of Energy-sponsored science and engineering research semester at Los Alamos National Laboratory in New Mexico. He presented papers at the Sigma Zeta National Convention at Hillsdale, Michigan, and at Butler University's Undergraduate Research Conference.

In the 1994 spring honors convocation for the School of Science and Engineering Technology, Mr. Taylor was awarded the Academic Achievement Award in Biology and the Scholastic Achievement Award in Science. Last year, he was a participant in the USI Honor Symposium.

On campus, Mr. Taylor served as vice-president of the Science and Ecology Club and was a member of the Student Government Association House of Representatives. He was also an active member of Sigma Zeta honorary, attending state and national conventions and serving as a judge for Sigma Zeta's high school science fair.

Mr. Taylor exhibited leadership abilities in his three-year student employee position,

prepping laboratories for genetics and medical microbiology classes. He assisted with the CASE (Career Awareness in Science and Engineering) program for middle school children at USI, and worked in monthly community-wide recycling programs. Mr. Taylor was an active participant in recruiting and orienting potential Presidential Scholars to USI.

Mr. Taylor is the son of Ronda Taylor. He graduated from Mississinewa High School.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in the holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

The Mace of the University

In medieval England, the mace was a formidable weapon, held ready by a bodyguard who led the way for dignitaries or officers of the court. From the sixteenth century in England and since colonial days in America, the mace has become a symbol of office only, and is carried by a distinguished member of the faculty who leads the Commencement procession. Here it is carried by the Grand Marshal.

The University of Southern Indiana Mace is the cane of Richard Owen, who was a geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University before becoming the first president of Purdue University. A respected scientist and scholar, Richard was a son of Robert Owen, the Scottish industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. All the children of Robert Owen who accompanied him to America made far-reaching contributions to society, and helped to shape the governmental, social, and cultural directions of the state, region, and nation.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremonies are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift of the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, Commencement scholarship honors are given only to baccalaureate students.
