



NACEP Reaccreditation Faculty Liaison Tasks & Deadlines



In 2025, 2027, the CAP Office will be preparing for and writing our NACEP reaccreditation application. As a faculty liaison, you have a small set of specific deliverables. This guide tells you exactly what to submit and when.

💰 \$200 Stipend: In addition to your regular CAP compensation, a one-time \$200 stipend will be paid upon completion of all accreditation-related documentation (*pending formal approval by O&E Executive Director*).

📄 Reminders Before You Begin

- Collect syllabi and sample assessments from all CAP instructors during fall 2026 (unless the course is only offered in spring).
- Clearly indicate which CAP syllabus and assessment should be used in the reaccreditation application and provide comparable on-campus pieces.
- Submit all materials electronically to cap@usi.edu

2026–2027	Collection of evidence and writing of coversheets
July 31, 2026	☆ <i>Liaison's professional development materials and narrative due to CAP Office</i>
October 16, 2026	☆ <i>Liaison's draft of Statement of Equivalency due to CAP Office</i>
December 1, 2026	Letter of intent submitted to NACEP
December 15, 2026	☆ <i>Sample materials and narrative for training new instructors, as well as best paired syllabi, paired assessments, and observation visit, due to CAP Office</i>
February 1, 2027	☆ <i>Liaison's final Statement of Equivalency due to CAP Office</i>
March 19, 2027	☆ <i>For courses only offered in spring: sample materials and narrative for training new instructors, as well as best paired syllabi, paired assessments, and observation visit, due to CAP Office</i>

June 15, 2027	Application due. Assigned to 3-person peer review team.
Fall 2027	Opportunity to answer questions and provide additional evidence.
Winter 2028	Virtual site visit from Peer Review Team
April 2028	NACEP Accreditation Commission vote — reaccreditation for 7-year period

 STIPEND ELIGIBLE <i>Hourly stipend already paid for new instructor orientation & syllabus review.</i>	<p>Provide for each discipline:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sample course-specific training materials • Agenda for new CAP instructor training • Written description of how new instructors are trained and how the evidence materials are used <p>Acceptable training activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-campus observation of the course or higher-level courses in the discipline 	<p> Notes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No new instructors in 2026–27? Simply write 1–2 paragraphs describing how a new instructor would be trained in the future. • Materials should go beyond a syllabus template.

<p style="text-align: center;"> STIPEND ELIGIBLE</p> <p><i>Hourly stipend already paid to facilitate annual PD.</i></p> <p><i>Lump stipend paid upon receipt of NACEP documentation.</i></p>	<p>Provide for each discipline:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Written description of the annual PD activity, authored by you as the faculty liaison • Description must address: how PD enhances course content or delivery knowledge; format, delivery method, and frequency; and how it is distinct from new instructor training <p>Supporting materials may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seminar description and materials • Event minutes or conference report (if pre-approved university-level conference) • Individualized meeting summary <p>Example PD activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recent journal article with documented discussion • Lab activity developed together to meet a course objective • Grade-norming activities • Activities identified during observation visits that address areas where instructors struggle 	<p> Notes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • *If meeting with CAP instructors after the July 29 conference, the deadline will be adjusted accordingly. • Explain from your perspective as facilitator: how did these materials deepen instructors' content or pedagogical knowledge?

 <p>STIPEND ELIGIBLE</p> <p><i>Lump stipend paid upon receipt of NACEP documentation.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write a Statement of Equivalency for your discipline following NACEP Guidelines • A generic or standard response is not acceptable — this must be specific to your course and department • The CAP Office will provide a template on letterhead with required areas to address <p>This single document satisfies both A1 and C2.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Address: departmental approach to the course, oversight of instructors, mandatory vs. discretionary components, grading scale guidance, and final exam requirements • See Appendix B Statement of Equivalency Guidelines for guiding questions and formatting requirements 	 Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feedback from CAP staff by Dec 15, 2026. • This is your opportunity to explain differences between on-campus and CAP syllabi — provide the CAP office with the best possible example.

 <p>STIPEND ELIGIBLE</p> <p><i>Stipend already paid as part of observation visit compensation.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide paired student assessment tools from on-campus and CAP sections of each discipline • Purpose: side-by-side comparison to demonstrate equivalency • Topics must be similar between the two sections <p>Acceptable formats:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Final exam, lab exercise, essay assignment, grading rubric, Core 39 key assignment 	 Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assessments do not need to be graded. • Collect strongest examples during fall 2026 observation visits and indicate which is best for your discipline.

C2	Paired Syllabi	 Due: Fall: Dec 15, 2026 Spring: Mar 19, 2027
 <p>STIPEND ELIGIBLE</p> <p><i>Already paid as part of observation visit compensation.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide paired syllabi from each discipline — one on-campus section and one CAP section • Syllabi must be from 26–27 and clearly labeled as such • Learning objectives must be incorporated into both syllabi • Use of the CAP or departmental syllabus template will help ensure the two syllabi are comparable • CAP can highlight learning objectives if needed 	 Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One CAP syllabus from your observation visits will be submitted to for comparison against the on-campus version.
C3	Site Visit Report	 Due: Fall: Dec 15, 2026 Spring: Mar 19, 2027
 <p>STIPEND ELIGIBLE</p> <p><i>Stipend paid per visit on a sliding scale based on distance from USI, upon receipt of visit form.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide one completed site visit report per discipline • Must be performed by a faculty member with content knowledge of the discipline <p>The report must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A description of what happens during a typical site visit • An explanation of how visits are used to provide feedback to CAP instructors 	 Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit should be made in 2026–27. • Ensure forms are fully completed and submitted with paired syllabi and assessments. • Indicate which example is strongest for your discipline.
