The above calendar and guidance below are meant to provide *general* guidance regarding the schedule during the second year of AFE, but speak to your professor and Mr. White if you are unsure.

Generally speaking, the **USI** courses are offered **Monday**, **Wednesday**, **Friday**. On **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays**, students will be in elementary schools on **field placement**.

- -When **EVSC** is open but **USI's** semester hasn't started or has already ended, AFE students will report to **Reitz** to meet with Mr. White.
- -When there is no school for **EVSC** on a Monday, Wednesday, or Friday, but **USI** is open, USI professors will post an asynchronous assignment in Blackboard. AFE students will not travel to USI.
- -When **USI** is closed on a Monday, Wednesday, or Friday, but **EVSC** is open, USI professors may post an asynchronous assignment in Blackboard. AFE students will report to Reitz instead of USI, to meet with Mr. White and work on USI assignments, if assigned. Students should not expect communication from USI professors.
- -When both EVSC and USI are closed on the same day, there is no class.
- -December 8 and 10, students will meet at USI according to the regular schedule, even though it's finals week at USI. A determination about spring finals week will be made in the spring by those professors.
