1. REPORT ON LEVERAGING THE HOLMUSK PARTNERSHIP TO BUILD MARKET LEADING COMPETENCIES

Dr. Sudesh Mujumdar, Dean, and Peyton Hopkins, a recent computer science graduate of the Romain College of Business, will share a project on applying machine learning to predict treatment adherence among patients with mental health conditions. Using Holmusk's NeuroBlu Analytics platform, Peyton accessed a large-scale clinical database, performed data preprocessing, cleaning, and exploratory analysis, and developed predictive models to identify factors influencing adherence to treatment. This experience provided exposure to an industry-grade data warehouse, deepened Peyton's understanding of how machine learning models "learn," and demonstrated how computer science can drive positive change in healthcare.
