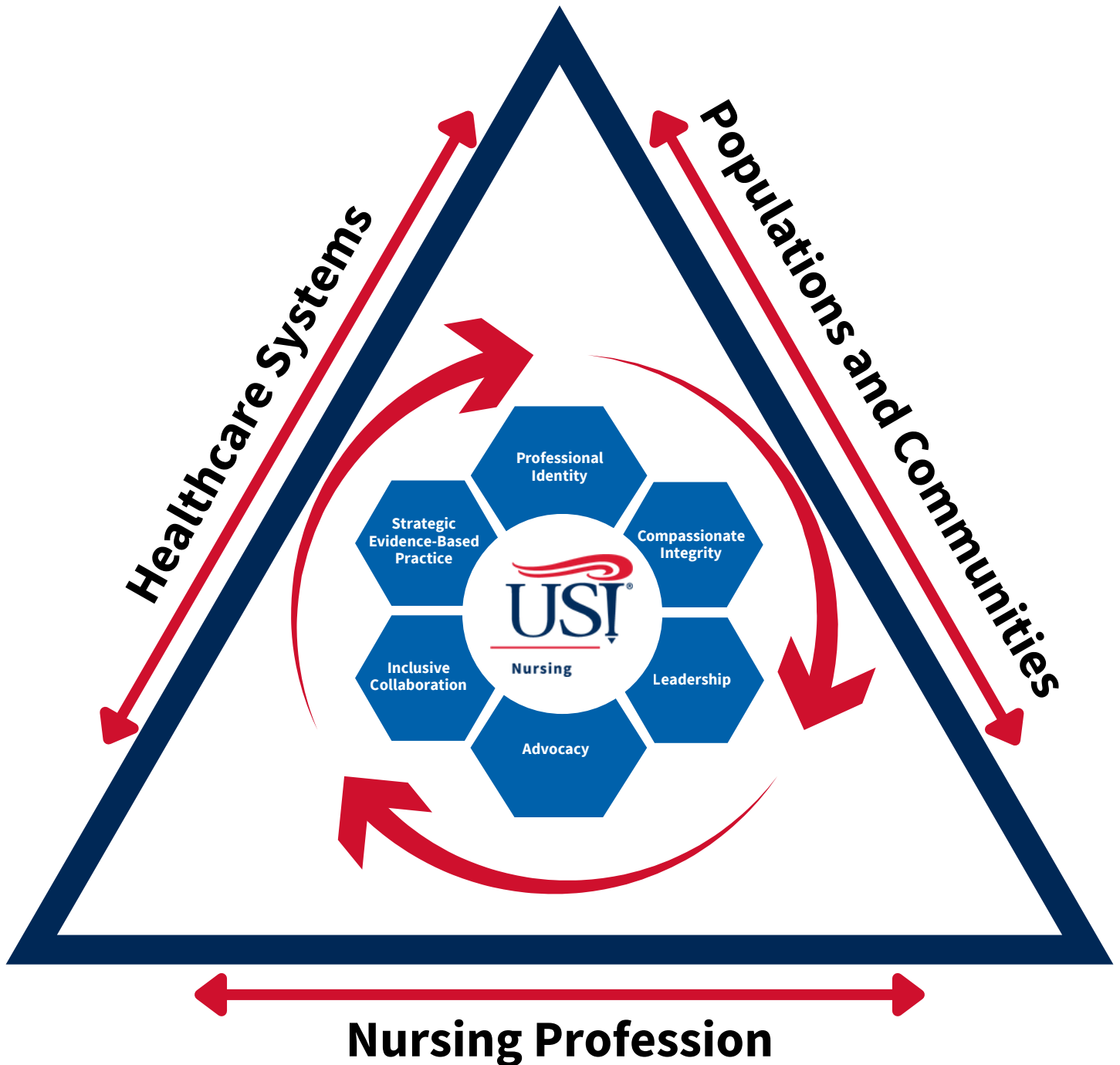


NURSING CONCEPTUAL MODEL & FRAMEWORK
