

Grand Valley Duo Headlines Daktronics Great Lakes Region Team

Inside and outside, courtside and far side, back court and front court, Grand Valley State has had everything covered this season.

The Lakers are 33-0 and along with Bentley, are ranked first in the nation. Inside, GVSU features 6-10 center Callistus Eziukwu. Outside, the Lakers have relied on 6-2 guard Jason Jamerson. Those two seniors have been named to the Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region First Team. GVSU is the only school with two players named to the all-region team.

Joining the Grand Valley State standouts on the first team are Drury guard Collins Harris, the Great Lakes Region player of the year, Kentucky Wesleyan center Jeff Fahnbulleh and Southern Indiana forward Norman Plummer. All five players on the first team are seniors.

The second team consists of Quincy guard Andre Muse, Hillsdale center Tony Gugino, Lewis forward Stephan Bolt, Gannon forward Vince Mosley and Findlay forward Josh Bostic. Both teams were selected by sports information directors in the Great Lakes Region. The members of the all-region first team advance to the Daktronics All-America ballot.

Eziukwu is the 2008 GLIAC player of the year. He's also a first team all-conference selection for the fourth consecutive year and is a member of the GLIAC All-Defensive Team for the fourth time. He was the MVP at last weekend's GLIAC Tournament. Eziukwu is averaging a team-high 15.6 ppg., 8.7 rpg., and is shooting 63.3 percent (210-332) from the floor. The GVSU center has rejected 78 shots. Eziukwu is third in NCAA Division II history in blocked shots (317) and he is fifth at Grand Valley State in career points. This year, he has 14 double-doubles and enters the NCAA playoffs with eight consecutive double-doubles.

Jamerson is averaging 14.3 ppg., and 4.2 rpg. The senior has hit 81-of-184 three-point field goal attempts (.440) and has 67 steals. Jamerson leads the Lakers in three-pointers, steals and assists. He has a 2.2-1.0 assist-turnover ratio and has reached double digits in scoring 25 times this season. The GVSU sharpshooter is a first team All-GLIAC selection and has been named the GLIAC player of the week four times in 2007-08. Jamerson was named to the 2008 GLIAC All-Tournament team

Harris is averaging 18.0 ppg., 4.7 rpg., and has 51 assists, 40 steals and 24 blocks. He's shooting 52.5 percent (197-of-375) from the field. The 6-5 forward was named to the All-GLVC First Team for the third straight year. Harris has scored in double figures in 27 of 30 games this season and has scored 20 or more points in 16 games. Drury is 25-5 and ranked 11th in the country. Harris led Drury to its first-ever GLVC Tournament championship last weekend.

Fahnbulleh is the GLVC player of the year. He averages 19.2 ppg., and 12.4 rpg. The KWC forward is second in the nation in rebounds per game. He is third in the GLVC in scoring and sixth in field goal percentage (.577). Fahnbulleh recorded 19 double-doubles this season, scored in double figures 25 times, posted a pair of 30-point games and had 15, 20-point games.

He yanked down 20 rebounds in one game and had 18 games with 10 or more boards. Kentucky Wesleyan is 24-7 and headed to the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Region Tournament.

Plummer averaged 19.5 ppg., and 10.7 rpg., this season. He is a first team All-GLVC choice. Plummer had two 18-rebound games this season. The senior leads the GLVC in scoring, if he maintains that position he'll be the first USI player to lead the loop in scoring since 1984-85. In December, Plummer was honored as the *Division II Bulletin* player of the month. Plummer put together 13 games where he scored 20 or more points and had 15 games where he had double digits in rebounds.
