#### **1. REPORT ON CURRENT AND NEW PROGRAM EVALUATION**

Dr. Shelly Blunt, Associate Provost for Academic Affairs; Dr. Wes Durham, Director of Bachelor of Professional Studies; and Dr. Zane Mitchell, Dean of Pott College of Science, Engineering, and Education; will discuss the evaluation of current and new programs at USI. Academic programs are essential to the vision and mission of the university. To ensure high-quality academic offerings, the university relies on a periodic program review process. The current process, along with modifications to this process, will be discussed. Additionally, the development of new and relevant academic offerings is critical to the growth and sustainability of the university. This fall department chairs, program directors and college deans learned about Gray Associates Program Evaluation System (PES+) to identify and evaluate potential new degree programs. PES+ will be discussed and modeled for a proposed graduate program in computer science at USI.

#### **2. COLLEGE STUDENT INVENTORY UPDATE**

Dr. Tim Schibik, Assistant Dean of the Romain College of Business and Ms. Kristina Walker, Director of Advising, will discuss how the Romain College of Business (RCOB) Advising Center is using the College Student Inventory (CSI) data to inform strategic interventions with at-risk first year RCOB students. Ruffalo Noel Levitz identified the overall risk index and predicted academic difficulty measures from the CSI as summary observations concerning students' level of risk. USI applied those two indicators to students who were not retained in the prior year (Fall 2021 cohort) and using some simple non-parametric statistics (Chi-Squared) were able to determine thresholds for interventions designed to improve student success (USI Strategic Goal 1). Both the passive and active interventions being implemented this fall will be discussed during the presentation, as well as some very preliminary observations.
